THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Arkansas opens its 93rd season of basketball in 2015-16 and the fifth under head coach Mike Anderson.
- The Razorbacks have won 41 straight home openers, including a 22-0 record in openers inside Bud Walton Arena.
- The Razorbacks have won 20 consecutive season openers and have opened the year in the win column in 42 of the last 44 seasons.
- Arkansas is 39-1 in non-conference games in bud Walton Arena under head coach Mike Anderson, including 24 straight wins. The only non-conference loss at home under Anderson came against Syracuse in 2012-13.
- The Razorbacks have won 53 consecutive games at home against unranked nonconference opponents, including a perfect 39-0 under Anderson.
- Mike Anderson coached teams have never lost a season opener, going 13-0 and averaging a 17-point margin of victory in those games.
- The Razorbacks are 1-0 all-time against Southern University, with the only meeting coming on Nov. 29, 1985 in Pine Bluff with Arkansas winning 76-75.

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 | Jabril Durham (G)

- Led the team in assists during both exhibitions, averaging 8.0 per game.
- Scored a season-best nine points against Dayton (Dec. 13) last season.
- Recorded six assists in back-to-back games last season to open the year.
- Tallied a game-high nine assists against SWOSU last week in exhibition play.

#5 || Anthion Bell (G)

- Scored an exhibition-high 21 points (8-for-12 field goals) vs. SW Oklahoma State.
- Leads all returners in points per game last season at 7.9.
- One of four players in school history to lead the team in three-pointers made for three straight years.
- Has made 148 career three-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history.
- Scored a game-high 21 points on 5-for-7 shooting from long range in the exhibition opener.

#24 | Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Shot 54.5 percent from the field and 90 percent from the foul line in exhibition play.
- A consensus top-80 player in the class of 2015.
- Participated in USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team mini-camp as Jr.
- Ranked No. 11 at his position and No. 1 in the state of Missouri by ESPN.com.
- Scored 19 points against SWOSU last week in exhibition play on 7-for-12 shooting from the field.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Led the team with 8.5 rebounds per game and seven offensive boards in exhibition play.
- Is 16 blocks from breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.
- Had three or more blocks in five games last season.
- Leads all returners in blocks last season with 38.
- Scored 27 points in the Red-White Game.

#55 | Keaton Miles (F)

- Second on the team with 8.0 rebounds per game during exhibition play.
- Played in 16 games last season as a redshirt-junior.
- Scored 10 points and added seven rebounds in the exhibition opener.
- Played a season-high eight minutes last year against Wake Forest (Nov. 19).
- Pulled down a season-high four rebounds against Delaware State (Nov. 21).

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Led team with 75 percent (6-for-8) shooting from the field in 18 minutes per game during exhibitions.
- Saw playing time in 14 games as a true freshman last season.
- Scored 13 points and pulled down five rebounds against SWOSU.
- Played a season-high six minutes two times last year.
- Tied for team-high nine rebounds in Red-White Game.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Shot 50 percent from behind the arc (5-for-10) in two exhibition contests.
- Sat out the 2014-15 season after transferring from Texas Tech.
- Played with USA East Coast basketball over the summer.
- Led Texas Tech in back-to-back seasons in three-pointers made.
- Hit a three-pointer in 47 of 62 games at Texas Tech.

#15 | Lorenzo Jenkins (G)

- Led First Baptist Academy in Naples, Florida, to three straight district titles.
- Named the Florida Class 3A District 18 Player of the Year in 2014-15.

#21 | Manuale Watkins (G)

- Played in all 36 games last season, averaging 2.6 points per contest.
- Leads all returners in steals last season with 37.
- Hit the game-winning shot with 6.4 seconds left at Ole Miss (Feb. 14).
- Recorded a double-double in Red-White Game with 14 points and 10 assists.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.
- Played in 27 games with 25 starts last season at Kennesaw State.
- Led Kennesaw State with 36 blocks last year.
- Scored four points and pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds against SWOSU last Thursday.

THE OPPONENT >>

- Southern University from Baton Rouge, Louisiana, plays in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). The Jaguars finished 18-17 last season, falling just shy of an NCAA Tournament bid with a 62-58 loss to Texas Southern in the SWAC championship game.
- Guards Adrian Rodgers (13.1 PPG) and Trelun Banks (10.3 PPG) are the top returners for Southern. The Jaguars averaged 4.3 three-pointers per game last season, and Rodgers and Banks can claim 88 of the 93 treys from returning players on the 2015-16 roster.
- Southern began the 2014-15 campaign with a difficult non-conference slate, where they went only 5-12, including losses at Ole Miss, Minnesota, lowa State and Baylor. The team rebounded, however, posting a 13-5 record in conference play, and then winning two games in the SWAC Tournament.
- After the Jaguars face the Razorbacks in Bud Walton Arena on Friday, they travel to Mississippi State for a matchup in Starkville on Monday, Nov. 16. The two SEC opponents are the only Power Five schools Southern will face in non-conference play.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons. Bell is also just 358 points shy from 1,000 career points.

THE ROAD AHEAD >>

- Arkansas will play six non-conference opponents that finished in the top 150 of the final NCAA RPI last season in Akron (124), Georgia Tech (147), Wake Forest (143), Evansville (82), Dayton (29) and Villanova (6) or Stanford (34).
- The Razorbacks will participate in the NIT Season Tip-Off, hosting Akron and Charleston Southern, before traveling to Brooklyn, N.Y. to play Georgia Tech and Villanova/Stanford.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

- Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.
- He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 67-8 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas is one of only four teams (Kentucky, Ohio State and Syracuse) in the country with 65+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four seasons.
- The Razorbacks have the 14th best winning percentage (.893) in the country at home over the past four seasons.
- Arkansas has won 24 straight non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 39-0 under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

A LOOK BACK >>

- Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.
- Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Little Rock native became the first player in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds by the end of his sophomore season
- The Razorbacks finished the 2014-15 season ranked in the top 25 nationally in 10 different categories, including turnover margin (8th), total assists (8th), assists per game (11th), free throws made (15th), total steals (17th), scoring offense (18th), free throw attempts (19th), win-lost percentage (21st), offensive rebounds per game (23rd) and assist turnover ratio (25th).
- Arkansas had a total home attendance of over 290,000 fans last year and ranked second in the SEC with 15,519 fans per game.
- Bud Walton Arena continued its rise in attendance last season, increasing the average fans per game for the fourth straight year and ranking No. 11 in the country.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 358 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 148 career three-point field goals, which ranks 10th all-time in school history.
- Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.
- Moses Kinglsey is 16 blocks away from breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
