THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Arkansas is playing in its fourth NIT Season Tip-Off in school history, holding a 5-4 all-time record in the tournament, including a 4-3 mark in Fayetteville.

- Arkansas is 40-2 (.952) in non-conference games in Bud Walton Arena under head coach Mike Anderson, with the only losses coming to Syracuse in 2012-13 and Akron on Wednesday night.

- Dating back to last season, Arkansas has won six straight games following a loss, posting victories by an average of 9.2 points per game.

- The Razorbacks are 1-0 all time against Charleston Southern, knocking off the Bucs 74-55 in 1984. Arkansas is 8-0 in program history against the Big South Conference.

- Arkansas is 4-0 on Nov. 20, earning victories over Florida A&M, Appalachian State, UC-Davis and Virginia.

- A Moses Kingsley double-double against Charleston Southern would make him the first Razorback in 19 years to open the year with three consecutive double-doubles. The last player to accomplish the feat was Derek Hood in 1996-97.

STARTING FIVE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Set career highs in points (4) rebounds (7) and minutes (21) against Akron.
- Made his first collegiate start Wednesday against Akron.
- Has already eclipsed his minutes total from the 2014-15 season.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Has started the year 9-for-9 from the free throw line and has made 24 straight foul shots dating back to his days at Texas Tech.
- Was Arkansas' second-leading scorer (21 points) vs. Southern University.
- One of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his Razorback debut.
- One of four players in the last 28 years to make five-plus three-pointers in his first game at Arkansas.

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Had a career-high 10 assists vs. Southern, more than any Arkansas player during the 2014-15 season.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Akron.
- His performance of 7 points, 4 rebounds and 10 assists was the first of its kind in the last 20 years of Razorback men's basketball (via @HogStats).
- Set a career-high in steals (5) and minutes (34) against Southern.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Scored 12 points in 26 minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Was one of three Razorbacks with multiple steals vs. Southern University (2).
- A consensus top-80 player in the class of 2015.
- Participated in USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team mini-camp as Jr.
- Ranked No. 11 at his position and No. 1 in the state of Missouri by ESPN.com.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- First Arkansas player since 2008-09 to have consecutive 12-plus rebounds to start the year.
- After one double-double in two years, he has two in as many games to open the year.
- Scored a career-high 22 points and added a career-high 3 steals vs. Southern.
- With an 8-of-8 shooting performance against Southern, he became the ninth player in program history make at least 8 shots and remain perfect from the field.

OFF THE PINE >>

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Has back-to-back double-digit scoring efforts for the seventh time in his career.
- Set career-highs in field goal attempts (20) and three-point attempts (13) against Akron.
- Came off the bench to score 14 points in 27 minutes vs. Southern University.
- One of four players in school history to lead the team in three-pointers made for three straight years.

#15 || Lorenzo Jenkins (G)

- Led First Baptist Academy in Naples, Florida, to three straight district titles.
- Named the Florida Class 3A District 18 Player of the Year in 2014-15.

#21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Scored a career-high 10 points against Akron.
- Grabbed a career-high 4 offensive rebounds vs. Southern University.
- Leads all returners in steals last season with 37.
- Hit the game-winning shot with 6.4 seconds left at Ole Miss (Feb. 14).

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Grabbed 3 rebounds in 8 minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.
- Played in 27 games with 25 starts last season at Kennesaw State.
- Led Kennesaw State with 36 blocks last year.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Made his first career start as a Razorback vs. Southern University.
- Scored 4 points and had 4 rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the season opener.
- Scored 10 points and added seven rebounds in the exhibition opener.
- Was the only Arkansas player other than Moses Kingsley to record a block against Southern.

THE OPPONENT >>

• Charleston Southern, a member of the Big South Conference, finished tied for first in the Big South last season, but lost in the first round of the conference tournament to ninth-seeded Longwood. The Bucs accepted a bid to the NIT and were knocked out in the first round at Old Dominion, 56-65 in Norfolk, Virginia.

• So far this season, CSU has already played two premier opponents on the road. The Bucs lost at Wichita State, 88-63, to open the season, then fell to the Stanford Cardinal, 93-59, in preliminary action of the NIT Season Tip-Off. CSU followed those two losses up with a 97-65 win over Johnson & Wales in the team's home opener on Wednesday night to climb to 1-2.

• The Bucs' offense revolves around two senior guards, Patrick Wallace and Demetrius Pollard. Through three games, Wallace (12.3) and Pollard (11.7) are the only two CSU players averaging double figures. Those two have combined to go 16-for-51 from beyond the arc, while the team is averaging 31.3 attempts per game from long range. Opponents are shooting 47.6 percent against the Bucs and outrebounding them by eight boards per game.

• Head coach Barclay Radebaugh is in his 11th year at CSU. He's the seventh-winningest coach in Big South history and one of eight coaches to win multiple Big South Coach of the Year awards. Last year's 19 overall wins and 13 victories in conference play were both program records as the Bucs captured their second regular-season title in the last three seasons. Before coming to Charleston, Radebaugh was an assistant coach at Miami (Fla.) for one year.

NIT TIP-OFF HISTORY >>

• Arkansas is playing in its fourth NIT Season Tip-Off in school history, holding a record of 5-4 all-time record in the tournament. The Razorbacks are 4-3 in the NIT Tip-Off in Fayetteville and next week's trip to New York will be the second semifinal appearance.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joins an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

• Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.

• He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

THREE-POINT BARRAGE >>

- Arkansas made eight three-pointers in each of its last three season openers after knocking down 8-of-15 treys against Southern. The Razorbacks rank fifth in the SEC, shooting 40 percent from long range.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 45 of the last 50 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 876 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance from long range against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- After having a Razorback hit five threes in a game twice all of last season (Bell twice), Arkansas has had players with five treys back-to-back in its first two games (Hannahs and Bell).

#NYLONBELL >>

- After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons. Bell is also just 321 points shy from 1,000 career points.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 321 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 155 career three-point field goals, which ranks 8th all-time in school history.
- Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.
- Moses Kinglesy is 10 blocks away from breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 68-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas is one of only four teams (Kentucky, Ohio State and Syracuse) in the country with 65+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four seasons.
- Arkansas has won 25 of its last 26 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 40-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

- Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.

- Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Little Rock native became the first player in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds by the end of his sophomore season

- The Razorbacks finished the 2014-15 season ranked in the top 25 nationally in 10 different categories, including turnover margin (8th), total assists (8th), assists per game (11th), free throws made (15th), total steals (17th), scoring offense (18th), free throw attempts (19th), win-lost percentage (21st), offensive rebounds per game (23rd) and assist turnover ratio (25th).

- Arkansas had a total home attendance of over 290,000 fans last year and ranked second in the SEC with 15,519 fans per game.

- Bud Walton Arena continued its rise in attendance last season, increasing the average fans per game for the fourth straight year and ranking No. 11 in the country.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
