## THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Arkansas returns to Bud Walton Arena to host Northwestern State after taking part in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y. at the Barclays Center.

- The Razorbacks have won 55 of their last 56 games at home against unranked non-conference opponents, including a 41-1 mark under Anderson.

- Anthlon Bell was named to the NIT Season Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after going 9-of-15 from behind the arc and scoring 31 points in two games. He went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span for 6 minutes and 34 seconds and turned a two-point deficit into a 19-point lead.

- The Razorbacks are 9-1 all-time against Northwestern State, including a 100-92 victory last season in Fayetteville. Arkansas has won eight straight against the Demons with the only loss coming in 1954.

- Arkansas 30-1 all-time against current teams in the Southland Conference, with the only loss coming to Northwestern State.

- Arkansas is 14-11 all-time on Dec. 1, with four straight wins over Oklahoma (2010), Oral Roberts (2007), Kansas State (1990) and Missouri State (1985). Dec. 1 features a pair of historic games with the Barnhill Arena opener in 1955 and the Razorbacks' first 100-point game in 1945.

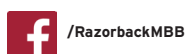
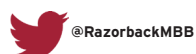

## STARTING FIVE >>

### #4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks sixth in the country with 7.8 assists per game.
- Has two of the five 10-plus assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Is the only player in the league with multiple double-digit assist games this season.
- Recorded a career-high 11 assists against Charleston Southern.
- Played a career-high 35 minutes against Stanford.

### #5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Named to the NIT Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after sinking 9-of-15 threes and scoring 31 points in two games.
- Has two games with five made three-pointers this year.
- Ranks second in the SEC with 18 made three-pointers on the season.
- Went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds.
- Is 278 points away from becoming the program's 39th player with 1,000 career points.
- Has five straight double-digit scoring efforts for the first time in his career.

### #24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Played a career-long 30 minutes against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Scored a career-high tying 14 points against Stanford.
- Has four double-digit scoring efforts in his first five collegiate games.
- Pulled down a career-high five rebounds against Charleston Southern.
- Scored 12 points in 26 minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.

### #33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has five consecutive double-digit scoring games to start the year.
- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- Joins LSU's Ben Simmons as the only SEC players averaging a double-double through five games.
- First Arkansas player since 2008-09 to have consecutive 12-plus rebound games to start the year.
- After one double-double in two years, he has three in five games to open the year.

### #55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Scored a season-high tying five points against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Tied a season-high with two field goals against Georgia Tech in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Played a season-long 29 minutes against Stanford.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Stanford.
- Made his first career start as a Razorback vs. Southern University.

## OFF THE PINE >>

### #1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Sat out against Stanford after suffering an ankle injury against Georgia Tech.
- Tied career high for points with four against Charleston Southern and Akron.
- Set a career with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first collegiate start against Akron.

### #3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Ranks No. 1 in the SEC with a .519 three-point field goal percentage.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring in two of the last three games.
- Was the fourth player in program history to make five treys in a game without a miss against CSU.
- Ranks No. 3 in the country with a .955 free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.
- One of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his Razorback debut.

### #21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Pulled down a career-high seven rebounds against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Has two double-digit scoring efforts in his career, both coming in the first four games of the year.
- Is 7-for-8 from the free throw line in the last four games.
- Played a season-high 25 minutes against Stanford.
- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.

### #50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (5), blocks (2) and minutes (15) against Georgia Tech in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Went 3-for-4 from the free throw line against Georgia Tech.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Pulled down two rebounds against Charleston Southern.
- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.

## WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

- Anthlon Bell (18) and Dusty Hannahs (14) have combined to drain 32 three-pointers, more than 128 teams in the country.
- Bell and Hannahs are the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC, sinking 32 treys on the year.
- Arkansas has had a player make five-plus three-pointers in four of five games this season after doing so just twice all of last year.
- Arkansas has made at least six three-pointers in all five games this season.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 48 of the last 53 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 879 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- Hannahs ranks No. 1 in the SEC with a .519 three-point field goal percentage, making 14 of 27 attempts from behind the arc.
- Hannahs is one of four players in school history to make five-plus three-pointers in a game without a miss when he went 5-for-5 against Charleston Southern.
- Bell went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.
- After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.



## HELP YOURSELF >>

- There have been five double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year, and Jabril Durham is responsible for two of them. He leads the league assists per game at 7.6 and is the only conference player with multiple double-digit assist games.

## PERFECT CHARITY >>

- Dusty Hannahs leads the SEC with a .995 free throw percentage, making 21-of-22 attempts on the year. Prior to his miss against Stanford in the NIT Season Tip-Off, Hannahs had made 34 straight free throws dating back to his days at Texas Tech. He ranks No. 3 in the country with a .955 free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.

## DOUBLE DIGIT MADNESS >>

- Arkansas has four players averaging double figures, but Dusty Hannahs, Moses Kingsley and Anthlon Bell have each scored double-digit points in all five games on the year. None of the three players had scored in double figures in four consecutive games before the current streak.

## BRAND NEW HOG >>

- Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

## ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

• Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.

• He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

## #NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

## RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

• Anthlon Bell is 278 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

• Bell has 169 career three-point field goals, which ranks 6th all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.

• Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.

• Moses Kinglsey is six blocks away from passing Bobby Portis and breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

## PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

• During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 69-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span.

• Arkansas is one of only four teams (Kentucky, Ohio State and Syracuse) in the country with 65+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.

• Arkansas has won 26 of its last 27 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 41-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

• Northwestern State (NSU), from Natchitoches, Louisiana, plays in the Southland Conference and is 1-5 on the season. The Demons are 0-3 against Power Five opponents thus far, including losses to SEC foes Ole Miss (90-76 on Nov. 13) and Auburn (119-81 on Nov. 27). NSU also fell to Arizona, 61-42, on Nov. 22, but responded three days later with its only win of the season at home, 86-80 against Louisiana College.

• The Demons are led by junior guard Zeek Woodley, who averages a team-best 23.8 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. Last year's leading scorer, Jalan West, is out for the season after suffering a knee injury in the opening game. Sophomore guard Devonte Hall leads NSU with 5.7 assists and 1.7 per game.

• Head coach Mike McConathy is in his 17th season with NSU, with a record of 260-245 (.515) in 16-plus seasons. Under McConathy, the Demons' best season was 2005-06, when they went 26-8 and secured a first-round NCAA Tournament victory over No. 3 seed Iowa. NSU also appeared in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, where it lost to No. 3 seed Florida. Overall, McConathy is in his 33rd season of coaching, having also spent 16 years at Bossier Parish Community College, where he amassed a 352-159 record.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
