'RUNNER STORYLINES

- ► CSUB dropped a road game at Delaware, 76-62, almost 2,500 miles from home.
- ► Freshman Jarkel Joiner tied his season-high with 23 points to lead all players. Redshirt senior Brent Wrapp chipped in 6 points, 7 assists, and 5 rebounds in the loss.
- ▶ Delaware outscored CSUB 20-9 off of just 11 turnovers from the `Runners.
- ▶ Jarkel Joiner leads all `Runners with 11.6 points per game. No CSUB freshman has finished the season as the top scorer since at least 1990.
- ► CSUB's scoring defense (67.4 points per game) ranks 86th in NCAA Division I.
- ▶ Redshirt junior **Damiyne Durham** needs just 32 points to reach 1,000 for his career.
- ▶ Brent Wrapp became the 2nd `Runner in CSUB history to record 500 points and 400 assists in a career after scoring 5 points vs. Life Pacific
- ► The `Runners lost 3 of 5 starters from a year ago (Jaylin Airington, Matt Smith, and Dedrick Basile), but returns senior starters Brent Wrapp and Shon Briggs.

CSUB HEAD COACH ROD BARNES

- ►Rod Barnes was named head men's basketball coach in March of 2011.
- ► Entering his 17th season as a collegiate coach, holds an overall record of 292-277 (.513) and is 106-88 (.552) in his seventh season at CSUB.
- ➤ 2017 College Insider Hugh
 Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year
- ▶2015-16 Western Athletic Conference 'Don Haskins Coach of the Year' award winner.
- ► The only player in the history of the SEC to earn both All-SEC (1988) and 'Coach of the Year' (2001).
- ▶2001 Naismith Coach of the Year.
- ► Has also been the head coach at Ole Miss (141-109 from 1998-2006) and Georgia State (44-79 from 2007-2011).
- ► Has served as an assistant coach at Livingston University (1990-1993), Ole Miss (1993-1996) and Oklahoma (2006-2007).
- ► Has led two teams to the NCAA Tournament (Ole Miss & CSUB).
- ► Led Ole Miss to the NCAA Tournament three times including a 2001 Sweet 16 appearance.

- ► Head Coach **Rod Barnes** was 0-2 as a student-athlete against Arkansas in his years at Ole Miss (1985-88).
- ▶ As Head Coach of the Rebels (1998-06), Barnes was much more successful against the Razorbacks, posting an 11-5 record.

ROWDY'S ROUNDUP

- ▶ The Roadrunners dropped a three-game win streak in a road loss at Delaware Dec. 20, 76-62.
- ▶ Freshman **Jarkel Joiner** tied his season-high with 23 points to lead all players. Redshirt senior **Brent Wrapp** chipped in 6 points, 7 assists, and 5 rebounds in the loss
- ▶ Delaware outscored CSUB 20-9 off of just 11 turnovers from the `Runners.
- ► CSUB and Delaware were similar in FG% (40 vs. 44), and 3FG% (33 vs. 37), but the Blue Hens went 22-of-33 from the FT line while CSUB made 15-of-18.

3RD ANNUAL EDUCATION DAY SOLD OUT

- ► CSUB secured its first sellout of the season for men's basketball for their Dec. 8 "Education Day" game against Life Pacific at the Icardo Center.
- ▶ 3,000 local elementary and middle school children took a field trip to the CSUB campus to experience a day in college.
- ▶ The `Runners sold out the Icardo Center for the first time in 20 years when they hosted New Mexico State in 2016. CSUB has since enjoyed hosting several sellout crowds and hopes "Education Day" was just the first of many this year.

THE WEST JUST GOT BIGGER

- ▶ On Monday, Nov. 27, CSU Bakersfield announced that it would accept an invitation to join the Big West Conference beginning July 1, 2020.
- ▶ The Roadrunners will join UC San Diego as the two new members, raising the league's membership to 11 universities along with Long Beach State, Cal State Fullerton, CSUN, Cal Poly, UC Irvine, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara, UC Davis, and Hawaii.
- ▶ The move will allow CSUB to decrease its average round-trip mileage from 2,400 with the WAC schools to 302 miles (excluding Hawaii, 814 miles with Hawaii included), which will greatly increase time in class and reduce spending on travel.

SO LONG, GREAT ALASKA SHOOTOUT

▶ The Roadrunners closed down the 40th and final edition of the Great Alaska Shootout with a bang. CSUB dominated host Alaska Anchorage, 59-39, in the first round. Nov. 22.

- ▶ After taking Thanksgiving off, the `Runners outlasted Idaho, 64-62, in dramatic fashion. The Vandals built 12-point lead early in the second half, but a 17-0 run by CSUB helped the `Runners take the lead back. Down by two points with seven seconds to go, Victor Sanders missed the front of end of a one-and-one. **Shon Briggs** went coast to coast for the `Runners, and kicked to the corner for redshirt freshman **Justin Davis**, who knocked down the eventual game-winning three-pointer with less than two seconds left on the clock.
- ▶ In the tournament finals, CSUB fell to Central Michigan, 75-72. Redshirt junior **Damiyne Durham's** 24 points weren't enough and the `Runners came up short on multiple three-pointers that would have tied the game late.
- ► For their efforts, **Shon Briggs** (10.3 ppg, 5.7 rpg, 3.3 apg) and junior guard **Rickey Holden** (14.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.3 apg) were named to the All-Tournament team.

CHARITY STRIPE PERFECTION

▶ Freshman Jarkel Joiner went a perfect 12-for-12 from the free throw line at Lamar on Nov. 19. The performance tied CSUB's Division I record for single-game free throw percentage held by the school's all-time leading scorer, **Stephon Carter**, who also went 12-for-12 in 2012-13 against La Verne. The school's all-time record is 14-for-14, **Kebu Stewart** at Cal State Hayward, 1995-95.

2016-17 SEASON RECAP

- ► CSU Bakersfield's men's basketball team experienced its second-straight season with exposure on the national level.
- ▶ Last season, the Roadrunners made a run through the National Invitational Tournament and eventually finding themselves competing inside Madison Square Garden in the NIT Semifinals. They became the first team in history to reach the semifinals as an eight-seed.
- ► CSUB ended their season in a loss against Georgia Tech on March 28,2017.
- ▶ 'Runners' defense was ranked third in NCAA Division I in opponents' field-goal percentage (37.2%), eighth in turnovers forced per game (16.6), 13th in total steals (286), and 22nd in points allowed per game (63.9).
- ▶ Set a new Division I record by recording 25 victories and eclipsing the 24-win season a year ago.
- ▶ Posted a 12-2 Western Athletic Conference, the best ever since joining the league in 2013.
- ▶ First, Western Athletic Conference regular-season championship title and the first men's basketball title since the 1997-98 CCAA Championship won at the Division II level.

RECORDS TO WATCH

- ▶ Brent Wrapp is currently second all-time for CSUB in career assists with 448. During the Great Alaska Shootout, the redshirt senior passed Fred Eckles (1989-92) for second all-time at 388 and added eight more in the last two games (UCLA &NAU). Wrapp has an outside shot at chasing down Kenny Warren's (1990-94) school record of 520. Wrapp has averaged 3.9 assists per game in his career.
- ▶ Damiyne Durham only needed two years to reach CSUB's Top 5 all-time for 3-point field goals made and attempted. The redshirt junior is ranked second all-time with 221 3FGM. Kenny Warren (1990-94) owns the record for 3FGM at 278 and Durham's average of 93 made per year would eclipse that total by one in just his third season as a `Runner. With four attempts against Georgia Southern Dec. 16, Durham reset the 3FGA record (641, Kenny Warren, 1990-94).

PRESEASON WAC HONORS

▶ Redshirt junior **Damiyne Durham** was selected Preseason First Team All-WAC in the coaches' poll. Senior **Shon Briggs** and redshirt senior **Brent Wrapp** earned Second Team nods.

▶ In the media poll, Durham dropped to the Second Team and was joined by Wrapp.

FORMER 'RUNNERS GOING PRO

- ► Former `Runner, **Tyrell Corbin** was named to the 15-man roster for the Charlotte Hornets NBA 2017 Summer league Corbin attended CSUB from 2013-15 and spent his last two season playing overseas for Bima Perkasa Jogja.
- ► Former 'Runner **Kevin Mays** signed a professional contract with BK Nova Hut Ostrava in the Czech Republic's NBL Mays was a first-team All-WAC selection in 2015-16, averaging 13 ppg and 8 rpg.
- ▶ Dedrick Basile, known for sinking the buzzer-beating three-pointer that sent CSUB to its first-ever NCAA Tournament, signed a contract with Alkar, a member of the top tier of Croatian basketball.
- ▶ Jaylin Airington inked a deal with Anwol of Poland this summer, a club that won the Polish league last year.
- ▶ Two-time All-WAC selection **Aly Ahmed** was drafted by the Sioux Falls Skyforce in the NBA Development League in 2016. Issues with his work visa that took too long to clear up caused Ahmed to miss his opportunity to join the Skyforce. Ahmed signed with the Cape Breton Highlanders of NBL Canada this fall. Ahmed was one of just four players in the history of CSUB to score at least 1,000 points and grab over 500 rebounds in his career.
- ▶ Ahmed became just the second Roadrunner ever drafted by the NBA D-League following **Tyrone White** who was selected in the third round by the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in 2014. White is currently playing professionally in Mexico.

EARLY SIGNINGS

- ▶ The Roadrunners welcomed their largest early signing class when four future Roadrunners signed their National Letters of Intent on Nov. 9.
- ▶ Darrin Person Jr. is a 6-7, 215-pound shooting guard from Immanuel High School in Reedley, Calif.
- ▶ Justin McCall, son of CSUB women's basketball head coach Greg McCall, is a forward from Ridgeview HS in Bakersfield.
- ▶ Jarkel Joiner is a point guard from Oxford HS in Oxford, Miss.
- ▶ Rickey Holden is the lone junior college signee, having played at Jones Community College in Ellisville, Miss.

`Runners in their first big dance in 2016

- ▶ For the first time in program history, the CSUB Roadrunners advanced to the 2016 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament where they fell to eventual Final Four participant Oklahoma 82-68 in the first round in Oklahoma City. The Roadrunners led several times during the game and trailed by just four points with just over four minutes remaining. It was the closest game Oklahoma had in the NCAA Tournament before losing to Villanova in the Final Four.
- ► CSUB was the second team that head coach **Rod Barnes** led to the NCAA Tournament after taking Ole Miss to the Dance three times ('99, '01, '02).
- ► Seniors **Aly Ahmed** (16 pts) and **Kevin Mays** (14 pts) led the way for the Roadrunners in their final career games for CSUB.
- ▶ **Dedrick Basile** scored 13 points for CSUB in the NCAA Tournament game including a 5-of-11 performance from the field and 3-of-7 from three-point range.


