STORYLINES

A LOT OF OFFENSE

- → Three different players (Tolefree, Monk and Dungee) have led Arkansas in scoring.
- → The same three players (Dungee, Monk and Tolefree) all average double figures with 18.8 ppg, 12.8 ppg and 12.1 ppg, respectively.

CAREER RECORD -----117-62 (6)

- \rightarrow Each of those three players have scored over 100 points this season.
- → Dungee, Monk and Tolefree have scored 393 of Arkansas' 672 points this season. That is nearly 60% (58.48) of the team's offense.
- \rightarrow Dungee, Monk and Tolefree have combined for seven 20+ point performances and they have 13 games with 15 or more points.
- → Dungee ranks third in the SEC followed by Monk at No. 23 and Tolefree at No. 30.
- \rightarrow Arkansas ranks **sixth in the SEC** averaging 74.7 points per game.

FUNCTIONALLY FAST

- → Play fast and don't turn it over is Arkansas' motto this year.
- → Possessions are important. Arkansas has taken 814 shots (598 FG+216 FT) with 375 (234 FG+141 FT) makes.
- → Arkansas has turned the ball over only 110 times a little more than Coach Neighbors would like but getting better each game.
- → The Razorbacks have played three games (Pitt, Iowa State, Tennessee Tech) with single-digit miscues.

BLOCK PARTY

- \rightarrow Arkansas set a school record against TTU with 13 blocks.
- → Kiara Williams had a career-best five blocks.
- → Macy Weaver had a career-high four blocks.





"Transitioning from one of the youngest teams in the country last season to a much more experienced squad this year, we felt like this season's game schedule should be more challenging," said seventh-year head coach Julie Goodenough. "We're excited to host for the first time ever, and maybe the only time, an SEC opponent in Arkansas. You just don't see Power 5 schools playing at mid majors very often so we want to maximize this rare occasion."

OPPONENT

- → The Wildcats are ranked No. 25 in the Mid-Major Top-25.
- \rightarrow The Wildcats opened the season with six consecutive wins before dropping a game at Tulsa.
- → Dominique Golightly leads four Wildcats who average double figures.
- \rightarrow Golightly has led the team in scoring in three games.
- \rightarrow The Wildcats average 1,600+ fans n a 4,600-seat arena.
- \rightarrow Look for ACU to get hands in the passing lanes. The Wildcats averaging 9.1 steals per game.

 \rightarrow Dungee leads the SEC with 45 made FT. Next best is 30 makes.

UNDER 10

 \rightarrow Arkansas has played five of its eight games to an under-10 point margin.

- → The Razorbacks have won two games by a single point (UT-Arlington, Wisconsin).
- → Arkansas lost to No. 22 Arizona State by one possession, three points.

→ Arkansas lost on a neutral site to Pitt by seven points and at No. 22 Iowa State by nine points.

THE PATH TO A MILESTONE

→ Malica Monk is on pace to score more than 1,000 career points as a Razorback. She enters the game with Abilene Christian with 966 career points. How did she get here?

→ Monk scored 110, 247 and 494 points, respectively, in each of her first three seasons.

→ Monk has 115 points as a senior through nine games - more points than she had in 27 games as a freshman.

→ Monk has eight made 3-point baskets. That is more than she had as a freshman (2) or a sophomore (7) in complete seasons.

 \rightarrow Monk has started 72 of 94 games including 67 in a row (She has missed some games with injury so the number is not consecutive).

→ She has scored in double figures in 49 games, had 11 games with 20+ points and led the team in scoring in 14 games.

 \rightarrow Monk will be the 28th player in program history to score 1,000+ points. She averages 10.3 ppg for her career and if she plays in 21 more games (every regular season game and one contest in the SEC Tournament), she will add 216.3 more points to her total for 1,182 career points. That

 \rightarrow One of the things Mike Neighbors stressed when he was hired was his desire to take care of the players, the staff and the fans who have been loyal to the Razorback program. He has told our fans that he wants them to stand "Beside Us". Don't be behind us, stand next to us and go through the process of building our program.

 \rightarrow You will notice the team and coaches line up and walk side-by-side from the half court line to the baseline of every game. It is a final moment of reflection, a chance to clear your head and a reminder that we are in this together.

HOME SWEET HOME

 \rightarrow Arkansas has had just one losing home season in 42 years (2009-10)

 \rightarrow Arkansas is 425-147 (3-1 in '18-'19) in home games including a 265-111 record in Bud Walton Arena. Arkansas was 159-35 in Barnhill Arena.

FROM MIKE NEIGHBORS

Here is a quick look at a couple observations from head coach Mike Neighbors about this year's team:

→ We are still small. There is no getting around it - Malica Monk did not grow in the off-season. This year, Arkansas has nine guards with Monk listed at 5-5 and Grayce Spangler and Chelsea Dungee at 5-11. If you look at the four guards who return with playing experience our average height is about 5-7.

→ We may be small but we are fast. Look for Arkansas to push the tempo even more this season. Not only do the Razorbacks have individually fast players, they have a lot of them so legs should be fresh for the entire game. → Neighbors is looking for a high number of shot attempts versus a low number of turnovers. Turnovers are a wasted possession - you don't have a chance to score. Last season, Arkansas took 2077 shots and committed just 360 turnovers. Arkansas ranked fifth in the SEC in shots taken and was first in the SEC with just 360 turnovers.

 \rightarrow Arkansas has more shot-makers this year. The Razorbacks return their leading scorer and add in a couple of redshirt players who made significant offensive contributions during the trip to Italy, the exhibitions and non-conference games.

MONK GETS PRESEASON NOD

Senior Malica Monk was selected as a Second-Team All-Southeastern Conference honoree in a vote by the league's coaches. Monk, a senior from Little Rock, Arkansas, led the Razorbacks and was 12th in the SEC averaging 15.9 points per game a year ago. Billed as one of the fastest players in the SEC, Monk also accounted for 3.4 rebounds per game, had a team-best 122 assists, made 38 3-pointers and went 114-146 from the line as a junior.

GIMMIE THE BALL

 $\rightarrow\,$ Malica Monk and Jailyn Mason are also climbing the career assists ladder.

 $\rightarrow\,$ Monk began the year tied for No. 17 in program history and has 21 assists this year. She is currently No. 14 overall.

→ Mason is just outside the top-25 with 203 assists.

ROOKIE NOD TO NAISMITH NOMINEE

In four short years Mike Neighbors went from a Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year nominee in 2014, to a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year national semifinalist in 2017.

Neighbors guided UW to an historic campaign in 2016-17 leading the Huskies to 27 wins, it's second most in program history, and he was just one shy of the all-time a school record set in 1990 (28).

Picked to place third in the Pac-12 in the preseason poll, UW tied for second in the league with a 15-3 record, it's best conference finish since 2003. The Huskies' 15 conference wins tied for third most in program history. Washington, who entered conference play with the program-best 12 non-conference wins, clinched its first-ever bye in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. Washington put together an 11-game win streak and a six-game win streak in Pac-12 play in 2016-17.


