- » Alecia Cooley scored a career-best 19 points leading three players in double figures in a win over ORU
- » Arkansas' 21 first-period points is the second-most in the opening 10 minutes this year
- » Arkansas' 16 third-period points is the third-lowest output of the year in that stanza
- » The Razorbacks have posted double figures in 31 of 36 periods played this year
- » The Razorbacks have matched or out-rebounded seven of nine opponents this season
- » All three of Arkansas' wins have been by 15 or more points
- » Three of Arkansas' losses are by single digits
- » If Jessica Jackson can surpass the 500 career rebounding mark, she will be one of 18 players in program history to record at least 1,000 points and 500 boards
- » Three players scored in double figures against ORU - it was the fourth time this year the Razorbacks have had three in double digits (SELA-5; South Dakota-3, Missouri State-3)
- » Arkansas averaged 60 points per game last year - this year, the Razorbacks have scored 60 or more points in five games



FASTEST TO 1,000

Jessica Jackson surpassed the 1,000 career point mark at South Dakota Nov. 18. She entered the year with 962 career points in her first two seasons and scored her 1,000th point in the first period at SDSU, ranking 27th at that time. Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons. **Jackson currently has 1,102 career points ranking 23rd.**

ALSO MOVING UP

- » Kelsey Brooks began the season ranked 49th all-time in scoring. Brooks tallied 633 career points in 62 games prior to the start of the 2015-16 season. She has 62 points this year, 695 career points and ranks 44th overall.
- » Melissa Wolff ranks 55th in career scoring with 577 career points.



- » Melissa Wolff ranks 20th for career rounds with 561.
- » Jessica Jackson ranks 32nd with 441 career rebounds.

ACTION JACKSON

Jessica Jackson started the season on fire. The junior from Jacksonville, Arkansas, opened with six consecutive double-digit games, had back-to-back double-doubles and four 20+ point games.

As a sophomore in the first four games, Jackson also had four consecutive double-digit scoring contests to open the year and one double-double.

FANTASTIC FOUR

Arkansas returns just four players from a year ago. That is the fewest returning players among SEC teams this season. Despite that low number, the Razorbacks return 63.59 percent of its scoring from a year ago with 1,221 of the team's 1,920 points coming from Jessica Jackson, Kelsey Brooks, Melissa Wolff and Khadijah West. Three of Arkansas' four leading scorers from last season (Jackson, Brooks and West) return.

TOUGH START TO SEC SCHEDULE

Arkansas faces one of the toughest starts to the SEC schedule for the second consecutive season. Last year, the Razorbacks opened SEC play with three of its first four opponents ranked in the AP Top 15. They were one of just two programs in the Power 5 Conferences to do that.

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2 South Carolina, vs. No. 15 Texas A&M, at No. 9 Mississippi State and vs. No. 16 Tennessee (AP).

Here is a look at Arkansas' opponents who are in the RPI top 100: Tennessee (27), Rutgers (15), Kentucky (12), Texas A&M (31), Florida (32), South Carolina (6), Missouri (26), Texas (48), Georgia (14), Oregon State (50), Florida (72), Auburn (49).

LONE WOLFF

Melissa Wolff is the only senior on the 2015-16 team. Named team captain, Wolff's leadership on and off the court will be heavily relied upon with eight newcomers to the Razorback family this year. Wolff led the team in rebounding last year with 7.8 per game and had six double doubles last year, including two in the NCAA Tournament.

As a senior, Wolff was a nominee for the WBCA, the NABC and Allstate Insurance Company's 2016 Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams®. In its fourth year, the Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball who have made outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. From establishing nonprofits that provide youth with the necessary tools to become leaders of tomorrow, to raising awareness around pertinent issues that could save lives, these student-athletes exhibit impeccable leadership skills both on and off the court.
