- Senior guard Empress Davenport named Big 12 Conference Player of the Week this week
- Davenport had a career-best 23 points in a win over No. 14/12 Stanford last weekend
- Senior Texas center Imani Boyette has been named to the early-season watch list for the 2016 Naismith Trophy
- Texas ranks among the best teams in the nation in several statistical categories. The Longhorns are sixth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 48.7 points per game, while ranking fifth in three-point field goal percentage defense.
- Texas has been ranked in every meeting between these teams
- In the 33 years women's basketball has been an NCAA-sanctioned sport, Texas has made 28 NCAA tournament appearances, three Final Fours and won one NCAA title (1986)
- The Longhorns have won 12 conference regular season titles and 10 conference tournament titles
- The Longhorns have a win over SEC members Tennessee, 64-53, and Mississippi State, 53-47, earlier this year.

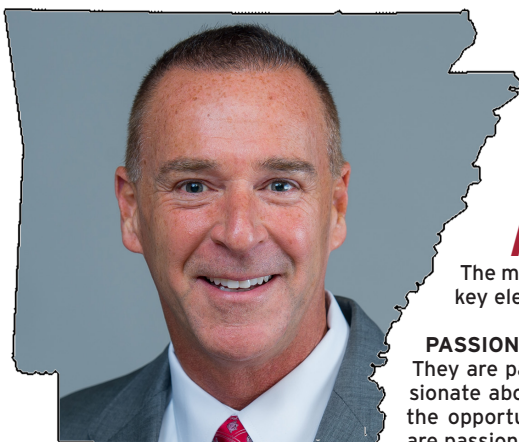

## FASTEST TO 1,000

Jessica Jackson surpassed the 1,000 career point mark at South Dakota Nov. 18. She entered the year with 962 career points in her first two seasons and scored her 1,000th point in the first period at SDSU, ranking 27th at that time. Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons. **Jackson currently has 1,117 career points ranking 22nd.**

## TOUGH START TO SEC SCHEDULE

Arkansas faces one of the toughest starts to the SEC schedule for the second consecutive season. Last year, the Razorbacks opened SEC play with three of its first four opponents ranked in the AP Top 15. They were one of just two programs in the Power 5 Conferences to do that.

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2 South Carolina, vs. No. 18 Texas A&M, at No. 9 Mississippi State and vs. No. 14 Tennessee (AP). The Razorbacks also face No. 5 Texas, No. 7 Oregon State, No. 8 Kentucky and Missouri, Georgia and Florida who are all receiving votes this week.

Here is a look at Arkansas' opponents who are in the RPI top 100: Georgia (7), South Carolina (11), Kentucky (15), Rutgers (16), Missouri (19), Texas (21), Tennessee (29), Oregon State (34), Florida (37), Texas A&M (41), South Dakota State (88) and Missouri State (96).

## LONE WOLFF

Melissa Wolff is the only senior on the 2015-16 team. Named team captain, Wolff's leadership on and off the court will be heavily relied upon with eight newcomers to the Razorback family this year. Wolff led the team in rebounding last year with 7.8 per game and had six double doubles last year, including two in the NCAA Tournament.

As a senior, Wolff was a nominee for the WBCA, the NABC and Allstate Insurance Company's 2016 Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams®. In its fourth year, the Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball who have made outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. From establishing nonprofits that provide youth with the necessary tools to become leaders of tomorrow, to raising awareness around pertinent issues that could save lives, these student-athletes exhibit impeccable leadership skills both on and off the court.

## MELISSA WOLFF HONORED AS A SENIOR OF SIGNIFICANCE

Razorback Melissa Wolff was recognized recently as a Senior of Significance by the College of Education and Health Professions and the University of Arkansas. The Alumni Association has been recognizing the outstanding graduate for more than 50 years. Expansion of the awards program took place in 2014 when the committee selected 71 outstanding Seniors of Significance in honor of the University of Arkansas founding year of 1871.
