- Freshman Jordan Danberry played well but the University of Arkansas women's basketball team couldn't make it three in a row, falling to No. 13 Mississippi State, 65-55, in Bud Walton Arena Sunday. Danberry finished with 12 points, went 4-for-4 from the line, have three rebounds and two assists in 21 minutes. Junior Jessica Jackson also had 12 points and five rebounds but the Razorbacks shot just 30.2% for the game against the sharp-shooting Bulldogs.
- Arkansas has already defeated two teams ranked No. 13 this season but couldn't pull off the trifecta versus the Bulldogs.

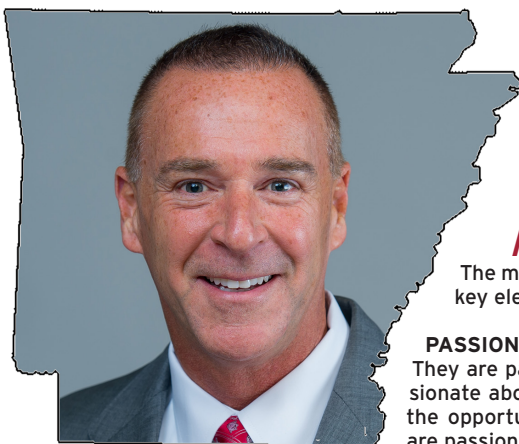

HEAD COACH

The most successful basketball programs all have a few key elements in common.

PASSION

They are passionate about the game. The coaches are passionate about their team, the players are passionate about the opportunity to represent their university and the fans are passionate about supporting the program.

EXCITEMENT

All successful programs are filled with excitement. They are exciting to watch and to be a part of.

COMMITMENT

It takes a lot of people to make a program successful and they all have to be committed to the effort. It starts with the coaches and staff and extends to the players but the best programs in the country take it further. Everyone who impacts the program, from professors, athletic trainers, academic coordinators, administrators and fans, all have to be willing to work toward the same goal of excellence in all areas.

PERFORMANCE

Finally, successful teams have to perform at a high level every day. Whether in the classroom, in the community or on the court, doing things the right way is vital to the program's success.

The University of Arkansas made a move March 30, 2014, when they welcomed Jimmy Dykes as the eighth head coach of the Razorback women's basketball team.

Georgia is tied for last place, yet is a mere 2+ games out of second place, and the Lady Dogs are included in this week's projected NCAA tournament field.

Jessica Jackson surpassed the 1,000 career point mark at South Dakota Nov. 18. She entered the year with 962 career points in her first two seasons and scored her 1,000th point in the first period at SDSU, ranking 27th at that time. Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons. **Jackson currently has 1,319 career points ranking 16th.**

ACTION JACKSON

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2/2 South Carolina, vs. No. 13/10 Texas A&M, at No. 7/6 Mississippi State and vs. No. 13/15 Tennessee (AP/Coaches). The Razorbacks also faced No. 5 Texas, No. 7 Oregon State and have Kentucky, Missouri, Georgia, Auburn and Florida who have been ranked or are receiving votes this year.

MORE ABOUT THE SCHEDULE

Arkansas opens SEC play facing five consecutive opponents who started conference play ranked in the AP Top-25 (Dec. 28). The Razorbacks are the only team in the SEC to open with five teams who were ranked as of Dec. 28, and they face six ranked teams in the month of January. Arkansas also faced two other league teams who are getting votes in the poll. Several other SEC teams play at least five ranked teams in January but Arkansas is the only one to start that way.

In addition to being the only team in the SEC to start with that schedule, Arkansas is the only team in the power five conferences to begin with such a tough league start. Several members of the ACC have three or four ranked conference opponents on their January schedules but none start like the Razorbacks. No one in the Big 12 faces more than two ranked conference opponents in January. No one in the Big Ten has more than three. The Pac-12 has several teams who face five ranked conference opponents in the month of January but, again, no one who starts with five consecutive ranked conference teams.

LONE WOLFF

Melissa Wolff is the only senior on the 2015-16 team. Named team captain, Wolff's leadership on and off the court will be heavily relied upon with eight newcomers to the Razorback family this year. Wolff led the team in rebounding last year with 7.8 per game and had six double doubles last year, including two in the NCAA Tournament.

As a senior, Wolff was a nominee for the WBCA, the NABC and Allstate Insurance Company's 2016 Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams®. In its fourth year, the Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball who have made outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. From establishing nonprofits that provide youth with the necessary tools to become leaders of tomorrow, to raising awareness around pertinent issues that could save lives, these student-athletes exhibit impeccable leadership skills both on and off the court.

WOLFF A SENIOR OF SIGNIFICANCE

Razorback Melissa Wolff was recognized recently as a Senior of Significance by the College of Education and Health Professions and the University of Arkansas. The Alumni Association has been recognizing the outstanding graduate for more than 50 years. Expansion of the awards program took place in 2014 when the committee selected 71 outstanding Seniors of Significance in honor of the University of Arkansas founding year of 1871. Razorback student-athletes represented nearly 13 percent of the entire Seniors of Significance class this year. Hundreds of students were nominated by the faculty and staff on campus. Completed applications were then reviewed by more than 100 alumni and university employees to select the top 71. The Seniors of Significance honored represent the top 2% from the Class of 2016.
