NEWS & NOTES

- » Arkansas plays just it's second true road game of the season, traveling to Rutgers for a Sunday afternoon contest
- » The Razorbacks are 0-3 all-time against Rutgers, falling, most recently, in Bud Walton Arena last season
- » Jessica Jackson ranks third in the SEC averaging 17.6 points per game and is 12th in the league with 8.0 rebounds per game
- » Kelsey Brooks is third in the SEC in assist/turnover ratio with a 4.2 average
- » In games that Arkansas has won, the Razorbacks have out-scored opponents by a +32.0 margin and out-rebounded them by +21.0
- » Jessica Jackson averaged 16.5 ppg and 11.5 rpg in the Arkansas wins and elevated her point production to 18.0 ppg in the five losses
- » One of the biggest statistical differences between games won and lost is with the turnovers. Arkansas is +10.0 on turnovers in games won and -2.4 in the losses.
- » Days of the week | Arkansas has played two games on Friday and two on Wednesday
- » On Fridays Arkansas is outscoring opponents 78.0-60.0 and outrebounding them 49.0-33.0
- » On Wednesdays, Arkansas is being outscored 61.5-72.5 but still holds the rebounding edge, 40.5-39.0

- Rutgers is 5-3 with losses at Seton Hall, versus St. John's and at Florida State
- Rutgers has wins over Saint Joseph's, Temple, Tulane, Virginia and Green Bay
- Two players, Kahleah Copper (18.6) and Little Rock, Arkansas Tyler Scaife (13.8) average in double figures
- Rutgers is out-scoring opponents by +1.6 ppg and out-rebounding them +1.5 rpg
- Rutgers is out-scoring opponents in three of the four periods (not in the third). The biggest margin is in the fourth period with a 146-108 advantage
- Rutgers dropped a 22 point decision at Florida State Thursday. Tyler Scaife was the only Scarlet Knight in double figures with 10 points.
- Rutgers out-rebounded FSU 38-28 but committed 23 turnovers in the loss

LAST MEETING

- Four Rutgers players were in double figures led by Kahleah Copper with 17 points. Betnijah Laney had a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds while Tyler Scaife added 13 and Rachel Hollivay had 10.
- Arkansas also had four players in double figures paced by Jessica Jackson with 14 points and eight rebounds. Jhasmin Bowen had 13 points and Melissa Wolff and Kelsey Brooks had 11 points each.
- Arkansas shot just 28.1% in the 64-52 loss last year and was out-rebounded by a 38-44 margin
- The Razorbacks dominated the offensive glass 13-7 and committed just nine turnovers against the Scarlet Knights who were ranked No. 18 in the AP and No. 20 in the coaches polls
- Arkansas matched Rutgers in the second half with each team scoring 28 points
- Jhasmin Bowen went 5-for-6 from the line helping Arkansas go 12-for-19 and shoot 63.2% for the game
- Arkansas hit four three-pointers, two by Brooks and one each for Jackson and Calli Berna, while holding Rutgers without a make from long distance

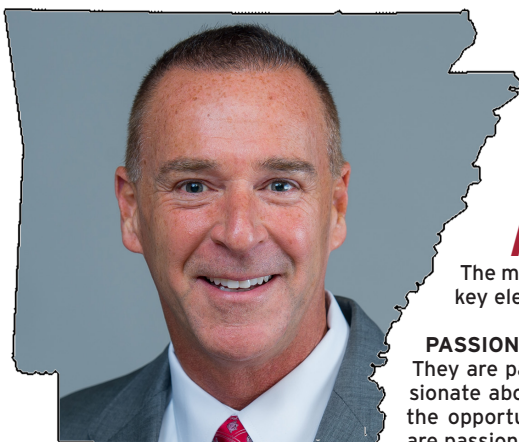

FASTEST TO 1,000

Jessica Jackson surpassed the 1,000 career point mark at South Dakota Nov. 18. She entered the year with 962 career points in her first two seasons and scored her 1,000th point in the first period at SDSU, ranking 27th at that time. Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons. **Jackson currently has 1,085 career points ranking 23rd.**

ALSO MOVING UP

- » Kelsey Brooks began the season ranked 49th all-time in scoring. Brooks tallied 633 career points in 62 games prior to the start of the 2015-16 season. She has 62 points this year, 695 career points and ranks 44th overall.
- » Melissa Wolff ranks 57th in career scoring with 569 career points.
- » Melissa Wolff ranks 21st for career rounds with 542.



- » Jessica Jackson ranks 32nd with 437 career rebounds.

ACTION JACKSON

Jessica Jackson started the season on fire. The junior from Jacksonville, Arkansas, opened with six consecutive double-digit games, had back-to-back double-doubles and four 20+ point games.

As a sophomore in the first four games, Jackson also had four consecutive double-digit scoring contests to open the year and one double-double.

FANTASTIC FOUR

Arkansas returns just four players from a year ago. That is the fewest returning players among SEC teams this season. Despite that low number, the Razorbacks return 63.59 percent of its scoring from a year ago with 1,221 of the team's 1,920 points coming from Jessica Jackson, Kelsey Brooks, Melissa Wolff and Khadijah West. Three of Arkansas' four leading scorers from last season (Jackson, Brooks and West) return.

TOUGH START TO SEC SCHEDULE

Arkansas faces one of the toughest starts to the SEC schedule for the second consecutive season. Last year, the Razorbacks opened SEC play with three of its first four opponents ranked in the AP Top 15. They were one of just two programs in the Power 5 Conferences to do that.

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2 South Carolina, vs. No. 16 Texas A&M, at No. 13 Mississippi State and vs. No. 4 Tennessee (AP).

Here is a look at Arkansas' opponents who are in the RPI top 100: Tennessee (7), Rutgers (9), Kentucky (10), Texas A&M (12), South Carolina (14), Missouri (19), Texas (33), Georgia (41), Oregon State (42), Florida (72), Auburn (81).

LONE WOLFF

Melissa Wolff is the only senior on the 2015-16 team. Named team captain, Wolff's leadership on and off the court will be heavily relied upon with eight newcomers to the Razorback family this year. Wolff led the team in rebounding last year with 7.8 per game and had six double doubles last year, including two in the NCAA Tournament.

As a senior, Wolff was a nominee for the WBCA, the NABC and Allstate Insurance Company's 2016 Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams®. In its fourth year, the Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball who have made outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. From establishing nonprofits that provide youth with the necessary tools to become leaders of tomorrow, to raising awareness around pertinent issues that could save lives, these student-athletes exhibit impeccable leadership skills both on and off the court.
