2015 Arkansas Razorback Baseball Team

40-25 Overall Record • 14th Consecutive NCAA Tournament 8th College World Series • Four MLB Draft Picks



LEADING OFF --

- The Razorbacks were one of just five teams in the nation to advance to the NCAA Tournament each of the last 14 years. Arkansas is joined by Cal State Fullerton, Florida State, Miami (Fla.) and Rice as the only programs to accomplish the feat.
- Arkansas advanced to the College World Series for eighth time in program history, making appearances in 1979, 1985, 1987, 1989, 2004, 2009, 2012 and now 2015.
- Arkansas finished its postseason run with a 71-61 all-time record in the NCAA Tournament, including 17 tournament wins in the last four years.
- The Razorbacks are one of 10 teams in the country to advance to at least three of the last seven College World Series, joining Florida, LSU, North Carolina, South Carolina, TCU, Texas, UCLA, Vanderbilt and Virginia.
- The Razorbacks have won 40 or more games in six of the last seven seasons.
- Arkansas had four players selected in the 2015 MLB Draft, as Andrew Benintendi went seventh overall to the Boston Red Sox, Trey Killian went in the ninth round to the Colorado Rockies, Bobby Wernes went in the 30th round to the Houston Astros and Tyler Spoon went in the 35th round to the Boston Red Sox. The Razorbacks have had 21 players drafted in the last the years.

Van Horn by the Numbers

- Dave Van Horn made his sixth career appearance in the College World Series during the 2015 season, more than any other head coach in the SEC.
- In his 13 seasons at Arkansas, Van Horn has led the Razorbacks to four College World Series appearances, five Super Regionals and 13 NCAA Tournament berths.
- The skipper eclipsed the 500-win mark at Arkansas on April 5 against Auburn and has a total of 524 wins, averaging more than 40 wins per season.

#BennyBaseball's Banner Year

- Won the Golden Spikes Award as the top amateur baseball player in the country and the Dick Howser Trophy as the top collegiate player in the nation. Earned four different National Player of the Year honors.
- Became the third player in SEC history to lead the league in home runs and batting average. He joins Rafael Palmeiro (Miss State in '84) and Jeff Abbott (UK in '94) as the only players in conference history to accomplish the feat.
- Became the first player in school history to lead the country in home runs, launching 20 #BennyBombs.
- Became the first NCAA Division I player since Western Kentucky's Wade Gaynor in 2009 to hit 20 home runs and steal 20 bases in a season.
- Is the fifth player in program history to hit 20 or more home runs in a season.

The Baum Way

- Arkansas finished No. 2 in the country in average attendance for the third straight year with 8,290 fans per game. The Razorbacks posted school records in actual attendance and tickets sold for a single game.
- The actual crowd of 12,167 against Missouri State on June 6 was the largest crowd in Baum Stadium history. The 12,167 fans also marked the third largest Super Regional crowd in NCAA history.
- The three NCAA Fayetteville Super Regional crowds marked the three largest crowds in Baum Stadium history.
- Arkansas was home to three of the top four postseason crowds in 2015 during Regionals and Super Regionals.
- The 12,589 tickets sold against Mississippi State on April 25 marked the 14th largest on-campus crowd in NCAA history.

#BennyBaseball Breakdown

- Was the first SEC Player of the Year in program history.
- Was the first National Player of the Year in program history.
- Was the first Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy winner in program history.
- Was the first Razorback to win a major SEC award since Nick Schmidt won Pitcher of the Year in 2006.
- Is the first player in school history with at least 15 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.
- Was the first NCAA Division I player in seven years to hit 20-plus home runs and steal 20-plus bases.
- Was the first player in SEC history to win the batting title, home run title and Player of the Year.
- Became the third player in SEC history to finish the year as the league leader in home runs and batting average.
- Was the first Razorback in school history to lead the nation in home runs (20).
- Was one of only two players in the country with 15-plus home runs and 20-plus stolen bases.
- Led the SEC in batting average, home runs, slugging percentage, on base percentage and walks.
- Led all sophomores in the country in batting average, home runs and slugging percentage.
- Is one of five players in school history to hit at least 20 home runs in a season.

Power

- Led the nation with 20 home runs on the year.
- Finished third in the country with a .717 slugging percentage.
- His .717 slugging percentage ranked him seventh all-time in Razorback history for a single season.
- Finished sixth in the SEC with 57 RBI on the year.
- Had a span of four home runs in six plate appearances against Mississippi Valley State and Kentucky.

Consistency

- Led the SEC with a .488 on base percentage.
- Led the SEC with a .376 batting average (Highest in the CWS).
- His .376 batting average was the highest at Arkansas since 2010, when Zack Cox set the school record at .429.

- Finished third in the SEC with 162 total bases.
- Finished tied for fourth in the SEC with 24 stolen bases on the year.
- Finished fourth in the SEC with 62 runs scored.

Dynamic Duo

Andrew Benintendi and Bobby Portis are one of only two baseball and men's basketball SEC Player of the Year combos in the same calendar year in league history. They join Florida's Mike Zunino and Chandler Persons in 2011 as the only other tandem to accomplish the feat.

- In eight NCAA Tournament games, Arkansas out-hit its opponents four times, was out-hit three times and tallied equal hits once. The Razorbacks ended the year 33-2 when out-hitting its opponents, but just 7-23 when being out-hit or having equal hits.
- After setting the Baum Stadium attendance record in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional with 11,869, Razorback fans followed suit Saturday, breaking the record in less than 24 hours with 12,167 on hand. In the Fayetteville Super Regional, three of the top four attendance marks at the eight Super Regional sites were all at Baum Stadium, totaling 35,730 over the three games. Game 1: 11,869 | Game 2: 12,167 | Game 3: 11,694
- Since the series win against Kentucky April 10-12, the Razorback pitching staff was 9-1 when it received a quality start.
- The Razorbacks won 7 of 10 conference series twice in the last three seasons (2015, 2013) as well as fourstraight SEC road series for the first time since 2007.

Crossing the Stage

Five current Arkansas players graduated the weekend of May 8-10, as Joe Serrano, Tyler Spoon, Krisjon Wilkerson, Jackson Lowery and Lance Phillips all received their diplomas from the University of Arkansas. Current student assistants Jake Wise and Tim Carver also graduated, while former players Cade Lynch and Geoffrey Davenport completed their degrees.

Leading the Pack

Arkansas is the only team in the SEC to advance to each of the last 14 NCAA Regionals, and head coach Dave Van Horn is the only current head coach in the league to make six appearances in the College World Series.

Road Warriors

Arkansas went to work on the road since April 18, winning 13 of its last 18 games away from Baum Stadium. The Razorbacks had been on the road for each of their last five NCAA Regionals, posting a record of 12-6, including a perfect 3-0 record during the 2012 Houston Regional and 2015 Stillwater Regional.

Coming Full Circle

Michael Bernal saw his collegiate career come full circle in the Stillwater Regional after starting his career at Oklahoma State and redshirting his first year before transferring to New Mexico Junior College for one season. Bernal hit .400 last week in Stillwater and was named to the All-Tournament team with a 4-for-10 performance, including two runs scored and two RBI's.

Jackson to Play for USA Baseball this Summer

Zach Jackson has accepted an invitation to join the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team this summer and will be the 13th Arkansas player to don the Red. White and Blue, Dave Van Horn served as the head coach last year. while Trey Killian was also selected to the team. "To get an invite to go play for your country and represent the USA against other countries around the world is something I've always dreamed of," said Jackson. "It's definitely an honor and humbling experience."



Now in his 13th season at the helm of the Arkansas baseball [program in 2015, head coach Dave Van Horn has elevated the Razorbacks to one of the nation's premier teams year in and year out. In 13 years at Arkansas, Van Horn has led Arkansas to four College World Series appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament berths, one Southeastern Conference overall title, three SEC Western Division championships and averaged more than 40 wins a season.

In 2014, Van Horn led the Razorbacks to their 13th consecutive NCAA Tournament, making the program one of seven teams in the country to advance to the NCAA Tournament each of the last 13 seasons. Arkansas surged into the SEC Tournament as the No. 7 seed after winning six of its final seven regular season games.

Arkansas continued to push its best talent to the next level following the season, as six players were taken in the 2014 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, with five of those signing professional deals. In a testament to the development of players once they arrive on campus, since 2009, 35 of the 36 Arkansas players that have been drafted have improved their draft stock by becoming a Razorback.

Following the 2014 season, Van Horn's coaching duties were far from finished as he became the manager of the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Leading the best collegiate players in the country against some of the top teams in the world, Van Horn and Team USA battled the Chinese Taipei in a fivegame series, Japan in a three-game set and made trips to The Netherlands and Cuba. The squad finished with an overall record of 18-8-2 and captured the Haarlem-Honkbal Week Championship in The Netherlands.



Credentials are nontransferable.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Please direct all requests for interviews with coaches and players to David Beall. For home SEC weekends, Coach Dave Van Horn will hold his weekly press conference on Thursday with players and assistant coaches available following Thursday's practice. On road SEC weekends, Coach Van Horn will hold his weekly press conference on Wednesday with players and assistant coaches available following Wednesday's practice. Players are not available for interviews on gamedays, except for post-game interviews. Post-game press conferences are held in the indoor batting cages located down the third base line. Coach Van Horn will address the media first, followed by the two or three most requested Razorback players. In the event of a doubleheader, the only Arkansas player available between games for interviews is the starting pitcher of game one. The Arkansas clubhouse is off limits to the media at all times.

E-MAIL UPDATES

Members of the media may request to be added to the Arkansas communications baseball e-mail group. Subscribers will receive game notes, game stories and other information. To subscribe, send a request to David Beall. Please identify yourself and your organization in your request as this service is only available to members of the media.

GAMEDAY MEDIA SERVICES

The Arkansas communications staff provides scorecards, rosters, updated statistics and results for each team in the Baum Stadium press box prior to home games. Box scores, play-by-play and any postgame notes are disseminated approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game. An Associated Press-style game story is also produced by the communications office. Members of the media may request these stories be sent to their organization via e-mail by contacting a member of the communications office.

For the 24th consecutive season, every pitch of the Arkansas baseball season can be heard on the Razorback Sports Network from IMG College. 


