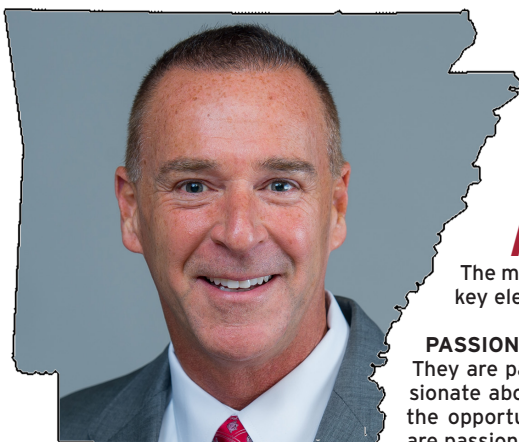

Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons.
