Meet the Staff

University of Arkansas Head Coach

Mark Cook:

Mark will be managing the camp and assisting on bars, as well as overseeing all camp events and providing his expertise. Coach Cook has led the Gymback team to two Super Six appearances at NCAA Championships. He also coached former Gymback Katherine Grable to an individual Vault title at the 2014 NCAA Championships. Additionally, he has coached numerous All-Americans.

University of Arkansas Associate Head Coach

Samantha Snider:

A former University of Arkansas gymnast, Snider has helped guide the team to 3 NCAA Championship appearances and a Super Six appearances as well. She has coached multiple All Americans on Floor during her time as an assistant coach at Arkansas. She also coached former Gymback Katherine Grable to an individual Floor title at the 2014 NCAA Championships. She will handle administrative duties, as well as coaching during camp.

University of Arkansas Assistant Coach

Jaime Armbrust:

Jaime Armbrust is in her third year as Arkansas' assistant coach after closing an outstanding Razorback career in 2012 and two seasons as the Director of Operations. She led Arkansas to two Super Six appearances, four NCAA Championship appearances and three top 10 finishes. Armbrust will sustain her coaching duties on the floor exercise and will handle administrative duties, as well as coaching during camp.

Joining the staff will be current Razorback gymnasts and top collegiate and club coaches from around the country.

Facility

Gymnasts will train in the Bev Lewis Center and Barnhill Arena. Camp dances will be learned and performed next door in Barnhill Arena. The Bev Lewis Center is a multi-million dollar facility and is home of the Razorback Gymnastics Team. The training gym is considered one of the finest facilities in the country. Dedicated in 2003, the center is named after Executive Associate Athletic Director, Bev Lewis. The 15,000 square foot air-conditioned facility is complete with a fully equipped training room and includes:

What to Bring

Everyone should bring t-shirts, shorts, leotards, comfortable shoes, and any personal gymnastics equipment (grips, wrist guards, & tape). In addition, overnight campers need to bring pajamas, toiletries, pillow, blanket/sleeping bag, towels, bed linens for a twin bed, door decorations (optional) and bathing suits (optional).

Air Travel

Overnight campers arriving via air at Northwest Arkansas Regional Airport must call no later than three weeks prior to the camp date to arrange transportation to camp via Super Shuttle. Call (479) 575-4479 to make travel arrangements. There will be a one-way \$45 transportation charge (\$90 round trip) to and from the airport, via Super Shuttle Service.

Housing

Overnight campers will be staying at the Maple Hill dorms. Gymnasts will have supervision from camp staff and counselors at all times, and the residence hall will be staffed around the clock. Maple Hill Dorms are located on the corner of Razorback Rd. and Cleveland St.

There will also be a camp store open to purchase snacks.



Roommates

Roommate requests are to be made on the camp application. Make sure your roommate puts you down on her application as well. The dorms are designed in such a way that there are two girls per room. However, you may request a suite that includes two rooms that share a common room. Anyone who does not specify a roommate will be paired with another gymnast of approximately the same age.
