

PREVIOUS GAME

- »Trailed 37-30 at the half. 3-3 when trailing at half.
- »Three players in double figures.
- »Devin Cosper with her fourth double-double.
- »Devin Cosper had a career high for points (25) and rebounds (14).
- »Forced double figure turnovers for the ninth consecutive game.
- »Outscored (43-35) and outrebounded (29-24) Charlotte in second half.
- »Seven offensive rebounds and 18 total rebounds in the 3Q are program highs for the period.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

- »The Razorbacks are the only SEC team that does not return a double-figure scorer.
- »Devin Cosper averaged 6.4 ppg last year and is up to a team-leading 18.8 ppg - up 12.4 ppg.
- »Arkansas leads the SEC and ranks sixth in the country for fewest turnovers with just 91 this year.
- »Arkansas leads the SEC and is second in the country with just 10.1 turnovers per game.
- »Devin Cosper is first in the SEC and third in the NCAA with 85 3-point field goal attempts. She is second in the SEC with 26 made 3's and first in the league in 3-pointers per game with 3.25 per game.
- »Malica Monk is third in the SEC averaging 34.25 minutes per game.

STORYLINES

Tulsa Ties

- »TU head coach Matilda (Willis) Mossman was the head coach at Arkansas for three seasons (1981-84) with a 67-27 record.
- »Former Razorback assistant coach Tari Cummings is an assistant at Tulsa.
- »Arkansas head coach Mike Neighbors was an assistant at TU from 2002-05 helping the team to a 69-62 record.

Streaks

»Devin Cosper has scored in double figures in all nine games. She scored in double figures 15 times as a sophomore - five in a row was her best streak. She had eight games in double figures last year with two in a row as her best run.

»Malica Monk has scored in double figures in every game. She had three double-digit games as a freshman and 13 as a sophomore. Her longest streak was three in a row set twice last year.

Better Numbers

»Devin Cosper had only scored 20+ points once entering this season. She has four games with 20 or more points this year.

GRAD STUDENT DEVIN COSPER

- »Only "senior" on the team
- »Missed the opening game last season after a death in the family
- »Averaged 6.4 ppg and 2.2 rpg last season and 7.7 ppg and 2.8 rpg for her career
- »Graduated in May 2017 with a degree in broadcast journalism
- »Interned at RSN, Arkansas' broadcast studio
- »Wears the SEC graduate patch on her jersey
- »Named "Comback Student-Athlete of the Year at annual HOGSPY awards after rebounding from an injury and a death in the family

FUNCTIONALLY FAST

You will hear Mike Neighbors say this a lot. He wants his teams to play as fast as possible and still function at a high level. That may look different from possession to possession depending on what Arkansas is running.

TRUST, TALENT AND TIME

My program will be built on three things. It's very simple.

TRUST - The highest form of loyalty that has to be earned, managed and sometimes re-earned. If we don't have this, nothing will work and the stool's legs will fall off and everything will collapse.

TALENT - It doesn't mean you can dribble, shoot, pass and rebound. It's a lot of other things like the ability to engage with the fan base and willingness to sign autographs for a 10-year-old child you might be inspiring.

TIME - It's just not being on time or making time. It's how you utilize your time and who you invest your time with and be around. Trust, talent and time. Those will be our pillars.

BESIDE US

One of the things Mike Neighbors stressed when he was hired was his desire to take care of the players, the staff and the fans who have been loyal to the Razorback program. He has told our fans that he wants them to stand "Beside Us". Don't be behind us, stand next to us and go through the process of building our program.

SHOTS AND POSSESSIONS

Mike Neighbors wants a lot of shots and a lot of possessions. Here's a look at the Razorbacks shots this year. The number is often determined by pace of play and Arkansas will push the tempo.

30 AND COUNTING

This year, Arkansas director of operations Amber Shirey enters her 30th season as a Razorback. The former Amber Nicholas was a two-time All-Southwest Conference selection during her four-year playing career from 1989-92. She spent one season (1992-93) as a student coach helping Arkansas transition to the Southeastern Conference. She moved on to a graduate assistant and assistant coach from 1993-94 through the 2006-07 season. In 2007-08 Shirey transitioned to the director of operations position holding that spot until she returned to the sidelines as an assistant coach for the 2013 and 2014 seasons. She moved into her current position as the Executive Director of Operations in 2014-15. She has been a part of seven different head coach's staffs during her tenure.

ABOUT TULSA

- »Shug Dickson leads the team in scoring and opened the year with six consecutive double-figure scoring games. She has not played in the last two games.
- »Dickson (15.1), Crystal Polk (10.4), and Alexis Gaulden (10.0) are all averaging double figures.
- »Tulsa has turned the ball over 10+ times in seven of nine games.
- »Tulsa went 11-for-19 from distance against Arkansas-PB in their most recent game.
- »Tulsa's bigs are all 6-2 and under. The heights are similar to Arkansas which should make for good match-ups in the paint.

IMPORTANT STATS

From Distance: Arkansas enters the game with 65 made 3-pointers while the 49ers have made just 26. They are efficient, shooting 31.7% from beyond the arc but average just 3.25 made 3-pointers per game.

Turn Them Over: The 49ers can be forced into turnovers. Charlotte enters the game with 135 miscues and a -2.2 turnover margin. Arkansas has just 81 turnovers and has a +6.6 turnover margin.

LINEUPS

- »Arkansas' most common lineup has been Monk, Williams, Mason, Cosper and Zimmerman the five starters in each game this year.
- »This group has played 95.46 minutes together, scored 186 points and allowed 151 points for a +35 rating and a +14.62 points per 40 minutes
- »The second most common lineup is Monk, Cosper, Thomas, Northcross-Baker and Swenson.

THE SCHEDULE

Arkansas' non-conference schedule features four teams who went to the post season a year ago. Arizona State played in the first round of the NCAA Tournament while Abilene Christian, UT-Arlington and Grambling were all WNIT teams a year ago. UTA was eliminated in the first round while Abilene Christian and Grambling both reached round two.

The always-tough SEC schedule features eight NCAA Tournament teams including the NCAA Champion South Carolina and the runner up, Mississippi State. Auburn and LSU were eliminated in the first round while Kentucky,

Missouri, Tennessee and Texas A&M all bowed out **HOME SWEET HOME** in round two. In addition, Alabama and Ole Miss advanced to the WNIT Tournament. That means Arkansas faces 14 teams who played in the postseason a year ago.

FROM ROOKIE NOD TO NAISMITH NOMINEE

In four short years Mike Neighbors went from a Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year nominee in 2014, to a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year national semifinalist in 2017.

Neighbors guided UW to an historic campaign in 2016-17 leading the Huskies to 27 wins, it's second most in program history, and he was just one shy of the all-time a school record set in 1990 (28).

Picked to place third in the Pac-12 in the preseason poll, UW tied for second in the league with a 15-3 record, it's best conference finish since 2003. The Huskies' 15 conference wins tied for third most in program history. Washington, who entered conference play with the program-best 12 non-conference wins, clinched its first-ever bye in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. Washington put together an 11-game win streak and a six-game win streak in Pac-12 play in 2016-17.
