INSIDE THE MATCHUP

UTA and Arkansas are meeting for the 7th time all-time with the Razorbacks taking all previous 6 meetings.

- UTA is 5-23 all-time against teams currently in the SEC.
- The Lady Mavs are 0-3 against Power 5 teams this season, falling to Utah, (RV) Kansas State and (RV) Georgia Tech.
- Sunday marks the final road nonconference game of the season, UTA is 1-3 on the road this year.
- Crystal Allen averaged a team-best 18.0 points per game last week, followed by Rebekah VanDijk with 14.0 and 11.5 rebounds.
- Unfortunate scoring streaks have plagued UTA in the L streak, UTA was outscored 27-6 in the 1st vs. Georgia Tech and a 16-0 run turned a doubledigit UTA lead around for KSU in the 2nd quarter.

IN THE NATION RANKINGS...

As of 12/7, UTA is 4th in 3-point % defense (20.9), 52nd in field goal % defense (36.0) and 73rd in scoring defense (59.3)... Rebekah VanDijk is 82nd in rebounds per game (9.0) and 97th in rebounds overall (72)... Crystal Allen is 141st in 3-point % (38.6).

LET'S NOT GO STREAKING

UTA's 4-game losing streak is its longest since dropping 4 in a row between 1/14-1/23 of 2016.

- Beyond 4 games, UTA's next longest L streak came in 2014 when it fell in 7 consecutive between Jan. 2 and Jan. 29 as part of just a 4-win season.
- On the positive side, following its previous 4-game streak, UTA went on to win 5 of 6.

• UTA IN THE USA TODAY COACHES' POLL

After a 2-game losing streak, UTA fell out of the receiving votes section of the poll. UTA received as many as 5 this season, after opening with 3 in the Preseason Poll.

• COLLEGEINSIDER MID-MAJOR POLL

UTA jumped up to No. 11 in the Collegelnsider. com Mid Major Poll, up from 17 last week, and a jump from just receiving votes in the preseason poll.

LOOKING BACK

Rebekah VanDijk's 2nd consecutive doubledouble was not enough as K-State topped UTA

 Georgia Tech made 12 consecutive field goals in the 1st to lead 27-6 after the opening 10. UTA brought the deficit down to 13 in the 2nd half, but couldnt get any closer.

MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Crystal Allen's 2 big games helped the senior claim the College Sports Madness Mid-Major Player of the Week award on Nov. 24. The 2nd Lady Maverick to earn the achievement to join Rebekah VanDijk, who did so last season.

• SBC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

The honors continued for Allen on Nov. 25, as the senior was named the league's Player of the Week, helping UTA sweep the day's awards (Eric Neal earned the award on the men's side).

- MILESTONE WATCH (More info on page 7)
 VanDijk enters her senior season in search of several all-time records. The 2016-17 1st-Team All-SBC member is within reach of becoming the 1st player in Lady Mav history to record both 1,000 pts and 1,000 rebounds. She is also approaching Lori Cottington's all-time rebound record of 1,078.
- Johnson, the 2016-17 SBC Defensive Player of the Year, has 250 career steals, needing just 35 to tie Allison Gray's all-time mark of 285. She is also 95 points away from becoming the 19th member of UTA's 1,000-pt club. Johnson is out the remainder of the 2017-18 season due to injury.

• DOUBLE-DOUBLE TROUBLE

In games that Rebekah VanDijk completes a double-double UTA is 24-15, including 10-4 the last two seasons. UTA is 0-2 this year when the senior records a double-double.

 LADY MAVS IN COSTA RICA The Lady Mavs took a preseason foreign tour in prep of the campaign. UTA went to Costa Rica for an 8-day, 4-game trek that saw UTA play a pair against both the Univ. of Ottawa and the CR National Team

• NEWCOMERS DEBUT AT UTA

UTA welcomes 6 that have taken the court for the first time this season. New Mexico JC transfers Laurynn McGowen and Daiane Machado join Brooke Alexander (RS SO), Jennifer Parker (FR), Kelsey Johnson (RS FR) and Michaela Wright (FR). Alexander joined from Liberty University, while Johnson was out with an injury last season. Alexander, Parker, Johnson and McGowen debuted against UIW in the opener.

• A PRETTY DIFFICULT SLATE...

In nonconference UTA has home matchups vs. SMU, Fresno State, Houston and San Francisco, while UTA visits UTSA, Utah, Kansas State, Georgia Tech and Arkansas.

 UTA has never played 4 Power 5 opponents in one season. In 2008, UTA had a stretch of 3 as well as TCU while the Frogs were in the MWC.

• SUN BELT LOOKING EVEN TOUGHER

From her first season into the second, the Lady Mavs increased their win total by 14, the second largest turnaround in Division I between the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. She guided UTA into the postseason in 2016-17 as UTA went to the WNIT.

Prior to UTA, Gerlich was a standout coach at West Texas A&M, making 4 NCAA DII Tournaments and won 3 conference titles.

In her playing career, Gerlich was a national champion at Texas Tech in 1993 and a part of 2 Southwest Conference titles. She finished as the all-time leader in 3-pointers (220) and still ranks amongst the top of Texas Tech 3-point and assist leaders. She was inducted in to the SWC Hall of Fame in 2004.

SIGNING CLASS

UTA welcomes a stellar class to the Lady Mav family. Five players make up the group, including Emma Halverson (Plano HS), Camryn Hawkins (Rio Rancho HS), Misty Dossey (Comanche HS), Claire Chastain (Dale HS), and Terryn Milton (Owasso HS). Milton's brother Shake Milton played at SMU.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

UTA was picked as the preseason favorites after a 22-win season and WNIT trip last year. UTA received 7 first-place votes and were ahead of No. 2 Little Rock and two-time defending league champ No. 3 Troy. Rebekah VanDijk was named the Preseason Player of the Year for a 2nd season in a row and joined Cierra Johnson on the league's first team. Crystal Allen was featured on the third team.

LETS GET COMPETITIVE

UTA's nonconference schedule is set to be a fun one with arguably the best slate in the Sun Belt. UTA opens with 3 games over 5 days before SMU comes to CPC on Nov. 19.
