STORYLINES

A LOT OF OFFENSE

- → The Razorbacks had seven players in double figures in the season opener against NSU. It is believed to be the first time seven players have been in double digits.
- → Arkansas hit 11 3-point field goals in the first game and five at UTA. The Razorbacks are shooting 48,7% from the floor including 37.9% from distance.
- → Newcomer Alexis Tolefree paced Arkansas in scoring with 19 in the opener and tied for the most points with 18 at UTA. Tolefree had a career-best 22 points against No. 22 Arizona State. She is one of three players averaging double-digits with 19.7 ppg. Chelsea Dungee (15.7) and Malica Monk (14.3) are the others.
- → 7, 3 and 4 the number of players in double figures in each game. Tolefree, Monk and Dungee have all scored in double figures in each game.

NAIL-BITER!

→ Alexis Tolefree received the inbounds pass from Jailyn Mason with just over three seconds remaining in the game at UTA. Trailing by one point, Tolefree made a move, took a couple of power dribbles and put up a jumper that rattled around the rim before falling in for the thrilling victory.

SO CLOSE

- → After trailing by as much as 10 points, Arkansas rallied but dropped a thrilling game to No. 22
- → The Sun Devils are the first ranked team Arkansas has faced this year but certainly won't be the last.

FUN FACTS

- → Arkansas is 23-9 all-time on the Friday after Thanksgiving.
- → Arkansas is 100-45 in-season tournaments.... 58-43 in road tournaments

ABOUT TENNESSEE STATE

- → Tennessee State is 0-3 on the season and faces Vanderbilt on Wednesday, Nov. 21.
- → Sophomore Taylor Roberts has scored in double figures in three consecutive games.
- → There losses have come at the hands of Lipscomb, Alabama A&M and Troy.
- → TSU opened the year with four consecutive road games.
- → This is the first meeting with Tennessee State for Mike Neighbors as a head coach.

ABOUT PITT

- → Pitt is 2-3 on the year after falling at Georgetown on Monday.
- → The Panthers' three losses are by an average of 12.6 points per game.
- \rightarrow Pitt is good from distance with 37 3-pointers this season. Cassidy Walsh leads the team with 10, followed by nine from Aysia Bugg and eight each from Alayna Gribble and Kyla Nelson.
- → Mike Neighbors has never coached against Pitt.

ABOUT WISCONSIN

- → Wisconsin opened the year 4-0 with wins over Winthrop, Milwaukee, North Dakota State and IUPUI in OT.
- → Badger freshman Imani Lewis has had two double-doubles this year.
- ightharpoonup Two players, Marsha Howard (.509) and Abby Laszewski (.552) are shooting better than 50% this year.
- $\rightarrow\,$ The Badgers excel on the boards with 200 rebounds in four games that puts them near the top-10 in the country.
- → Mike Neighbors is 1-0 all-time as a head coach against Wisconsin.

SERIES RECORDS

Pitt

- → Arkansas is 1-0 all-time against the Panthers.
- → The lone meting was in 1994 with a 76-5 Razorback win in Las Vegas.

Tennessee State

- → Arkansas is 2-0 all-time against the Tigers.
- → The first meeting was in 1988 with Arkansas getting a 114-42 win at a neutral site.
- → Arkansas picked up a 71-50 win in Fayetteville in 2010.

Wisconsin

- → Arkansas is 1-0 against the Badgers.
- → The lone meeting came in the championship game of the WNIT in 1999 with Arkansas getting a 67-64 win in front of the largest crowd in program history.

ARKANSAS IN THE SEC

- → Arkansas is third in the conference averaging 83.0 points per game.
- ightharpoonup The Razorbacks are second in the league shooting .487 going 92-for-189 through three games.
- → Arkansas is second in the SEC shooting .379 from distance with 22 made 3-pointers.
- → The Razorbacks are third in the SEC averaging 7.3 3-point field goals per game.

ARKANSAS INDIVIDUALS IN THE SEC

- → Alexis Tolefree ranks third in the SEC in scoring at 19.7 ppg. Chelsea Dungee is 11th with 15.7 ppg and Malica Monk ranks T-15 with 14.3 ppg.
- \rightarrow Kiara Williams is T-8 in the SEC in rebounds averaging 8.0 rpg.
- \rightarrow Chelsea Dungee is fifth in the SEC shooting 56.7% (17-30).
- → Chelsea Dungee ranks secon in the conference shooting 54.5% from 3-point range. Dungee is 6-for-11 this year.
- → Alexis Tolefree is second in 3-points field goals made with 3.7 per game.

MONK IN SEC CAREER LEADERS

- → Malica Monk ranks ninth among the SEC leaders for career points with 894.
- → Monk is fourth among active players for career assists wit 194.

HOME GROWN

- → Arkansas has six in-state players on the roster this year.
- ightarrow That is the most Arkansasans on the team since 2010 when there were seven in-state players
- → The Razorbacks have had 113 players from the state on its rosters with Little Rock producing the most with 11 student-athletes.

GUARD HEAVY

- → Arkansas has nine players who list their positions as guard or point guard and two others who are guard/forwards.
- → The guard-heavy lineup allows the Razor-backs to play "Functionally Fast" or as fast as they can while functioning at a high level.
- → Look for senior Malica Monk and redshirt sophomore A'Tyanna Gualden to handle the ball a lot. Both players are fast and don't make many mistakes.

WHAT'S HE SAYIN?

Don't be alarmed if you don't understand what Head Coach Mike Neighbors is saying on the bench. He has a language all his own.

Coach Neighbors plays "Positionless Basketball". Instead of having guards, forwards and centers, he has Rabbits, Rackers, Locks and Dragons.



Rabbits run the floor and look to score quickly with a layup.



Rackers are the player with the ball - go to the rack.

Locks are the players who are trying to win the race to the corners



The Dragon is the last player down the court. Watch out for a long distance shot from this spot.

WHAT'S NEW?

- → Arkansas' new players have stepped up early.
- → Junior college transfer Alexis Tolefree leads the team with 19.7 points per game with three consecutive games in double figures. Tolefree leads the team in points, scoring average, field goals made and attempted, 3-point field goals made and attempted, free throws made, steals and minutes.
- → Redshirt sophomore Chelsea Dungee is second on the team with 15.7 ppg and has also been in double digits in each of the first three games.
- → Redshirt sophomore A'Tyanna Gaulden is fourth with 7.3 ppg.

THREEEEEE POINT BASKET

- → Arkansas wants to be a 3-point shooting team.
- \rightarrow The Razorbacks have 22 made 3-pointers this year but had 27 makes threw the first three games last year.
- → The difference? The efficiency. Arkansas is shooting .379 from distance this season compared to .293 at the same time last year.

→ Coach Neighbors wants Arkansas to play as fast as they can function. That means move quickly but don't make a lot of mistakes and that is exactly what the Razorbacks did last year.

- → Arkansas led the SEC and ranked fourth in the nation for fewest turnovers with just 360 miscues in 31 games last season.
- → Arkansas has 189 field goal attempts and attempted 73 free throws for a total of 262 shots. They have 48 turnovers heading into the weekend.
- → Arkansas has scored double figure fast break points in all three games this year with a season-best 15 FB points at UT-Arlington.

SPEAKING OF FAST

Fast starts are something that the Razorbacks want to take advantage of this season. With speed and depth, it will be one of the advantages Arkansas has against bigger teams.

SOME THINGS REMAIN THE SAME TRUST, TALENT AND TIME

My program will be built on three things. It's very simple.

- → TRUST The highest form of loyalty that has to be earned, managed and sometimes reearned. If we don't have this, nothing will work and the stool's legs will fall off and everything will collapse.
- → TALENT It doesn't mean you can dribble, shoot, pass and rebound. It's a lot of other things like the ability to engage with the fan base and willingness to sign autographs for a 10-year-old child you might be inspiring.
- → TIME It's just not being on time or making time. It's how you utilize your time and who you invest your time with and be around.

Trust, talent and time. Those will be our pillars.

SIDE BY SIDE

- → One of the things Mike Neighbors stressed when he was hired was his desire to take care of the players, the staff and the fans who have been loyal to the Razorback program. He has told our fans that he wants them to stand "Beside Us". Don't be behind us, stand next to us and go through the process of building our program.
- → You will notice the team and coaches line up and walk side-by-side from the half court line to the baseline of every game. It is a final moment of reflection, a chance to clear your head and a reminder that we are in this together.

HOME SWEET HOME

- → Arkansas has had just one losing home season in 42 years (2009-10)
- → Arkansas is 423-147 (1-1 in '18-'19) in home games including a 264-111 record in Bud Walton Arena. Arkansas was 159-35 in Barnhill Arena.

FROM MIKE NEIGHBORS

Here is a quick look at a couple observations from head coach Mike Neighbors about this year's team:

- → We are still small. There is no getting around it - Malica Monk did not grow in the off-season. This year, Arkansas has nine guards with Monk listed at 5-5 and Grayce Spangler and Chelsea Dungee at 5-11. If you look at the four guards who return with playing experience our average height is about 5-7.
- → We may be small but we are fast. Look for Arkansas to push the tempo even more this season. Not only do the Razorbacks have individually fast players, they have a lot of them so legs should be fresh for the entire game.
- → Neighbors is looking for a high number of shot attempts versus a low number of turnovers. Turnovers are a wasted possession - you don't have a chance to score. Last season, Arkansas took 2077 shots and committed just 360 turnovers. Arkansas ranked fifth in the SEC in shots taken and was first in the SEC with just 360 turnovers.
- → Arkansas has more shot-makers this year. The Razorbacks return their leading scorer and add in a couple of redshirt players who made significant offensive contributions during the trip to Italy, the exhibitions and non-conference games.

- → Malica Monk returns as the team's leading scorer averaging 15.9 points per game.
- → Monk scored in double figures in 29 of 31 games as a junior including 14 games in a row to start the year. She has scored in double digits in each of the first three games this season.
- → Monk scored 20+ points 10 times including a career-best 25 points against No. 11 Tennessee on Feb. 8, 2018 as a junior.

MONK GETS PRESEASON NOD

Senior Malica Monk was selected as a Second-Team All-Southeastern Conference honoree in a vote by the league's coaches. Monk, a senior from Little Rock, Arkansas, led the Razorbacks and was 12th in the SEC averaging 15.9 points per game a year ago. Billed as one of the fastest players in the SEC, Monk also accounted for 3.4 rebounds per game, had a team-best 122 assists, made 38 3-pointers and went 114-146 from the line as a junior.

RECORDS WATCHTHE ROAD TO 1,000

- → Malica Monk begins the season with 894 career points and has 43 points this year.
- → She averages 10.2 ppg for her career and, if she plays in 28 more games (one game into the SEC Tournament), she would add 285.6 points to her total well over the 1,000-point plateau (1,179).
- → That milestone would make Monk the 28th player in program history to score 1,000 career points and would have her moving into the top-20 scorers at Arkansas.

ROOKIE NOD TO NAISMITH NOMINEE

In four short years Mike Neighbors went from a Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year nominee in 2014, to a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year national semifinalist in 2017.

Neighbors guided UW to an historic campaign in 2016-17 leading the Huskies to 27 wins, it's second most in program history, and he was just one shy of the all-time a school record set in 1990 (28).

Picked to place third in the Pac-12 in the preseason poll, UW tied for second in the league with a 15-3 record, it's best conference finish since 2003. The Huskies' 15 conference wins tied for third most in program history. Washington, who entered conference play with the program-best 12 non-conference wins, clinched its first-ever bye in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. Washington put together an 11-game win streak and a six-game win streak in Pac-12 play in 2016-17.
