TIPOFF

- Northwestern State opens the third season of the **Jordan Dupuy** era in the same state where it played its final game of the 2017-18. NSU, which closed this past season at Central Arkansas, last opened a season in the same state it closed its previous campaign across the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons (home vs. Stephen F. Austin, at New Orleans).
- Today's game marks the first of back-to-back early tipoffs for Northwestern State, which will host LeTourneau in a noon matchup on Monday.
- It also marks the second straight season the Lady Demons have started the season on the road against a Southeastern Conference opponents. NSU tipped of the 2017-18 season with a 71-44 loss at Ole Miss.
- Northwestern State had its streak of season-opening wins snapped at five with that loss at Ole Miss.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- Arkansas returns 10 letterwinners from its 2017-18 squad and adds Oklahoma transfer Chelsea Dungee and freshmen Alexis Tolefree and Rokie Doumbia to its roster.
- The Razorbacks have 80.3 percent of their scoring and 86.1 percent of their rebounding returning, including leading scorer Malica Monk (15.9 ppg) and top rebounder Kiara Williams (6.8 rpg).
- This is the sixth straight season Arkansas will host a Southland Conference team in its season opener.

THE SERIES WITH ARKANSAS

Northwestern State enjoyed some early success against Arkansas when the teams met yearly from 1980-1984. NSU captured two of its three wins in the 15-game series in the first three meetings, scoring a 73-62 victory during the 1980-81 season in Natchitoches and adding a 62-58 triumph in 1982-83 in Natchitoches. Arkansas has had the upper hand, winning the past nine meetings, including a 65-36 victory in the most recent matchup, a Dec. 18, 2016, matinee in Fayetteville.

THOMAS READY TO MAKE RETURN TO COURT

Point guard **Sami Thomas** is expected to start against Arkansas on Friday. The start itself is not news as Thomas, a fifth-year senior, has started 18 games in her career, including 17 in her junior season of 2016-17. That year was the last time Thomas suited up as a player. During a Feb. 18, 2017, loss to Abilene Christian, Thomas suffered a knee injury that cost her the final five games of that season as well as the entire 2017-18 season. Whenever Thomas steps on the Bud Walton Arena floor, it will mark the first time she has seen game action in 630 days.

CAN LADY DEMONS EXTEND RUN OF 30-POINT SCORERS?

Beginning with **Janelle Perez** in the 2014-15, Northwestern State has had at least one player score at least 30 points in a game in each of the past four seasons. Perez reached the 30-point plateau twice that season as Northwestern State captured its second straight Southland Conference Tournament championship. A year later, Perez tallied 30 points in a Southland tournament semifinal loss to Sam Houston State.

In 2016-17, **Beatrice Attura** and **Cheyenne Brown** twice went for at least 30 points in the same game while Attura added two more 30-point performances.

Most recently, **Libba Gilliam** enjoyed a career day at Southeastern Louisiana on Jan. 20, hitting 9 of 14 shots and finishing with 30 points in a 71-65 loss to the Lady Lions.

EARLY TO RISE FOR LADY DEMONS IN EARLY SEASON

Northwestern State's first two games of the season may not have any more different opponents in Southeastern Conference foe Arkansas and NCAA Division III member LeTourneau.

However, they will both be early starts. After tipping off the season at 10:30 a.m. against Arkansas, the Lady Demons will start at noon against LeTourneau in NSU's home opener. Both games are designated "School Day" games, allowing children to come to the games during the day.

BUD WALTON ARENA FAMILIAR FOR SEVERAL LADY DEMONS

With a veteran roster, it is no surprise numerous Lady Demons saw action two seasons ago when Northwestern State visited Arkansas.

Sami Thomas, Victoria Miller, Jocelyn Scott, Gabby Bell, Libba Gilliam and **Jasmyn Johnson** all saw action in that game. Thomas is the lone current Lady Demon to play at Arkansas more than once. In her freshman season of 2014-15, Thomas sank all four of her free throw attempts in a 78-30 Arkansas victory.

Northwestern States reputation as one of the cradles of college baseball head coaches has a direct tie to Arkansas.

Current Razorbacks head coach Dave Van Horn was the Demons' head coach for three seasons from 1994-97, capturing two Southland Conference titles while ringing up an overall record of 106-65, a .620 winning percentage.

Van Horn led the Razorbacks a national runner-up finish in 2018, falling to Oregon State in three games of the Colleg World Series finals.

Today's women's basketball matchup is the first of two athletic meetings between NSU and Arkansas as the Demons baseball team will visit Baum Stadium for two games in April.

BUILDING BLOCKS IN PLACE FOR GILLIAM, SCOTT, JOHNSON

In each of the past two seasons, senior forward **Libba Gilliam** has seen her scoring average raise by at least five points per game. After averaging 0.6 points per game in her freshman year, Gilliam shot up to 5.7 points per game during her sophomore season before cracking the double-figure scoring mark as a junior, averaging 10.7 points per game.

Gilliam hardly was alone in seeing her points per game total rise from 2016-17 to 2017-18.

Current juniors **Jocelyn Scott** and **Jasmyn Johnson** also increased their scoring averages by at least five points.

Behind a late-season surge in which she averaged 16 points across Northwestern State's final three games, Scott bumped her scoring average to 7.8 points per game, a 5.7-point jump from her freshman season.

From start to finish, Johnson was one of Northwestern State's most improved players, and it showed in her scoring average. One year after averaging 1.2 points per game, Johnson added 5.6 points per game to her average, tallying 6.8 points per game in 2017-18.

LADY DEMONS SPREAD OUT DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORING

In **Jordan Dupuy's** first two seasons at Northwestern State, the Lady Demons' offensive attack has resembled that of 20th-year NSU men's coach **Mike McConathy's** best teams. That is, in any given game, an NSU player was a threat to reach double figures in points.

In Dupuy's first season, eight players had at least one double-figure-scoring game. That number increased to 11 in Dupuy's second season. All but two players on the Lady Demons roster topped 10 points in a game.

Among that group, five different Lady Demons reached the 20-point mark in the 2017-18 season.

LIBBA AT THE LINE HAS BEEN MONEY

While the Lady Demons have not shot particularly well from the free-throw line as a team, junior forward **Libba Gilliam** has continued to display a deft touch from the charity stripe.

Gilliam connected on all seven of her free throws as a freshman and started her sophomore season by sinking 16 straight free throws. Gilliam hit 40 of 47 freebies during the 2016-17 season, good for an 85.1 percent clip. Through two seasons, Gilliam was an 87 percent free-throw shooter.

It was more of the same in her junior season. Gilliam started the season by hitting her first 41 free throws of the season before finishing the season 56 of 59 (94.9 percent). For her career, Gilliam is a 91.2 percent free throw shooter.

Last Time Out...

CONWAY, Ark. — Central Arkansas ranks just a notch off the NCAA lead in scoring defense, which explained a fair share of Northwestern State's struggles Saturday in a season-ending 59-39 Southland Conference women's basketball loss.

NSU, finishing 7-22 overall and 2-16 in an injury-riddled season, managed only 15 points in the first half when it didn't score for 9:40 bridging the first and second quarters as UCA grabbed a double-digit lead to stay.

UCA (21-8, 14-4) heads into next week's Southland Tournament as the No. 3 seed, while the Lady Demons didn't qualify for the eight-team field for the first time in six seasons.

Averaging 20 turnovers a game, NSU already had 14 by halftime as the Sugar Bears mounted a suffocating, physical defense.

"UCA does a great job defensively. That's well established and give them credit for a lot of our problems today," said second-year Lady Demons coach Jordan Dupuy. "But we only got up 33 shots. We had 24 turnovers and too many of them were not due to great defense. Turnovers have been a big problem for us all season."

Gabby Bell scored a team-high 10 points, hitting 3-of-4 on 3-pointers, for an NSU squad that was 6-for-14 behind the arc but only 6-of-21 inside it. NSU shot 36 percent overall while making all nine of its free throws, five in the fourth period.

UCA got 17 points by Taylor Baudoin and 15 points from Kamry Orr, with an overall 40 percent accuracy rate helped by sinking 17-of-24 at the free throw line. The Sugar Bears doubled up the visitors 16-8 in the first period, led 29-15 at the break and the Lady Demons never got closer afterward.

"It's been a frustrating season for us fighting injury after injury, and that never allowed us to develop any consistency because there were different players unavailable week in and week out," said Dupuy.

"The benefit of it is that the ones who were healthy got to play more, which will help us next year, considering Tia Youngblood is our only senior. We really appreciate her efforts for four years in this program, and also, how our fans have hung with us and been so encouraging. That has been really special for this team and these coaches."

The Lady Demons played significant portions of the season without their four top performers, playing nearly all year without preseason All-Southland forward Cheyenne Brown due to a knee injury and related problems. Dupuy and his program began looking forward shortly after Saturday's final buzzer.

"We end our season today and we already are working very hard on next year," he said. "While we're doing everything we can to get better, through offseason and recruiting work, we also will spend a lot of time this spring supporting baseball, softball, tennis and track and field. We are one big family here and it's going to be fun watching those sports this spring."

Two Games Ago...

THIBODAUX — The Northwestern State women's basketball team didn't equal its turnover total from the first meeting of the season with Nicholls.

Still, the multitude of mistakes by the Lady Demons added up to an 85-53 Southland Conference loss to the homestanding Colonels on Wednesday night at Stoper Gymnasium.

"We didn't play with any pride tonight, any passion," second-year head coach Jordan Dupuy said. "That's what we talked about before the game. Our theme for this game was to have no regrets. Honestly, there's no one who can have that mentality. They beat us to every loose ball. They wanted to play, and they played hard."

The Lady Demons (7-21, 2-15) dropped their seventh straight game thanks in large part to 24 turnovers, which led to a 21-12 advantage in points off turnovers for Nicholls (15-13, 10-7). In the first meeting between the teams on Dec. 28, the Lady Demons surrendered 31 turnovers.

The Colonels also controlled the glass, outrebounding Northwestern State by 21, grabbing 21 offensive rebounds.

"It's a will; it's mental toughness," Dupuy said of rebounding. "That kind of explains what we've been fighting all year. It's right there in the statistics."

While Nicholls won most of the loose balls Wednesday night, the Colonels also executed sharply on offense. Nicholls shot 57.1 percent from the field in the first half to open a 22-point lead at halftime.

In games against New Orleans and Southeastern Louisiana, the Lady Demons were able to slow Randi Brown and Taylin Underwood, two of the Southland's top scorers. Northwestern State had little answer for the SLC's third-leading scorer, Cassidy Barrios, on Wednesday.

Barrios finished with game highs in points (17), rebounds (11), steals (5) and blocks (3), producing her second double-double in two meetings with Northwestern State this season.

She led four Colonels in double figures, joining Tia Charles (16), Tykeria Williams (15) and Marina Lilly (12).

Jocelyn Scott followed up her career-high 26-point performance against Southeastern Louisiana on Saturday by leading Northwestern State with 15 points while Libba Gilliam added 11.

Freshman forward Lacee Savage scored seven points and grabbed a team-leading six rebounds for the Lady Demons. Additionally, Savage handed out a career-high three assists to pace Northwestern State.

"She was a bright spot," Dupuy said. "I can live with some of the mistakes she made, because she was playing hard. She was playing aggressive. There's times where she doesn't know what to do, but she's going hard in doing it. We played a lot of people a lot of minutes tonight. We're going to continue to develop our young people, and Lacee has a lot of bright moments ahead."

The Lady Demons conclude their season at 3 p.m. Saturday, facing two-time defending Southland champion Central Arkansas in Conway.

NEW COACHING FACES NEARLY EQUAL NEW PLAYERS

For the first time since taking over the Northwestern State job prior to the 2016-17 season, head coach **Jordan Dupuy** has new coaches sitting alongside him on the bench.

Dupuy added **Aaron A. Swinson** and **Nicole Mitchell** to his coaching staff as assistants this past offseason. Swinson most recently was the interim head coach at Prairie View A&M while Mitchell helped lead her alma mater, Christopher Newport, to a pair of NCAA Division III national tournament appearances in the past two seasons.

Swinson and Mitchell join associate head coach **Deneen Parker**, who is in her third season on Dupuy's staff.

The two new coaches are just one fewer than the number of new faces on the Lady Demons' roster.

Freshmen **Anna Bonham** and **RaVon Nero** along with junior college transfer **Kira Bonner** comprised NSU's 2018 recruiting class.

Bonham and Nero were the first two Oklahoma prep girls basketball players to sign with Northwestern State.

OPENERS HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFUL TIMES FOR NSU

While Northwestern State dropped its 2017-18 season opener at Ole Miss, the first game of the season often has been a good time for the Lady Demons.

NSU has won five of its past six season openers and holds a 28-16 mark in season starters. The four-game win streak between the 2013-14 and 2016-17 seasons was the second-longest in school history behind a seven-game streak from the 1987-88 season through 1993-94.
