- » Wisconsin enters the weekend 4-0 on the year after outlasting IUPUI 65-64 in overtime Monday, Nov. 19 in Madison.
- » The Badgers are led by senior Marsha Howard, who has scored in double figures for 11 consecutive games and leads the team in scoring (60 pts / 15.0 ppg) and rebounds (39 reb / 9.8 rpg).
- » As a team, Wisconsin has been aggressive on the boards, pulling down 200 total (50.0 rpg) and boast a +16.8 rebounding margin. The Badgers' 50.0 rpg rank third in the Big Ten.
- » Wisconsin finished the 2017-18 season 9-21 overall with a 2-14 mark against Big Ten foes. The Badgers return four starters from a year ago and welcomed seven newcomers this season.
- » Wisconsin is led by third-year head coach Jonathan Tsipis who is in his seventh year overall on the sidelines with a 114-81 career record.

- » Arkansas heads to Nashville with a 2-1 overall record after suffering its first loss of the season Sunday, Nov. 18 to No. 22 Arizona State, 85-83.
- » The Razorbacks are led by junior guard Alexis Tolefree with 59 points on the year and is averaging 19.7 ppg. As a team, Arkansas is averaging 83.0 points per game.
- » On the glass, junior forward Kiara Williams leads the way, pulling down 24 total boards and is averaging 8.0 on the year.
- » The Razorbacks finished the 2017-18 season 13-18 overall and 3-13 against SEC opponents.
- » Arkansas is led by second-year head coach Mike Neighbors who is in his sixth year on the sidelines. Neighbors own a 113-59 career record.

## A NEW CHAPTER

- » **Lance White** was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history Thursday, April 19, 2018.
- » Joining White on the sidelines this season is associate head coaches **Danielle Atkinson** and **Terri Mitchell**, and assistant coach **Josh Petersen**.
- » White came to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.
- » Since White's arrival at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards.
- » He helped Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.
- » For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.
- » Prior to joining the Seminoles' staff, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp.

## A LOOK AT THE OPPONENTS

- » Pitt is scheduled to play 16 games at the Petersen Events Center this season, including eight non-conference games and eight ACC games.
- » Eight home games at the Petersen Events Center highlight the Panthers' 14-game non-conference slate, including the 46th edition of the Backyard Brawl against West Virginia (Dec. 8).
- » In total, Pitt will face seven teams that competed in the 2018 postseason, including Northeast Conference Tournament champion and NCAA Tournament participant Saint Francis (Pa.) (Dec. 21).
- » The Panthers' ACC slate features home-and-home contests against 2018 NCAA Tournament participants Louisville (away Jan. 27, home March 3) and Syracuse (home Jan. 17, away Feb. 21). The Cards reached the Final Four, falling to runner-up Mississippi State, while the Orange fell in the first round to Oklahoma State.
- » In addition to Louisville and Syracuse, the Panthers' ACC home schedule at Petersen Events Center includes Boston College (Jan. 13), Clemson (Jan. 20), Virginia (Jan. 24), Virginia Tech (Jan. 31), Miami (Feb. 10) and North Carolina (Feb. 14).
- » Rounding out Pitt's ACC road schedule are trips to NC State (Jan. 10), Duke (Feb. 3), Georgia Tech (Feb. 7), Florida State (Feb. 17) and Wake Forest (Feb. 28).
- » The 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament will be held March 6-10 at Greensboro Coliseum in Greensboro, N.C.

## NEW PANTHERS

- » Three freshmen join the roster for the 2018-19 season in guards **Jahsyni Knight**, **Tehya Lyons** and **Ismi Prapa**.
- » Knight, a native of Perth Amboy, N.J., led Rutgers Prep to two consecutive NJSIAA State Championships, two Non-Public B Sectional titles and three consecutive Somerset county Championships. The guard was ranked 84th overall by ESPN and 78th overall by Bluestar Basketball.
- » Hailing from Norcross, Ga., Lyons was a three-star recruit, while ranking No. 28 at the guard position by ESPN. Lyons was a three-time regional champion at Norcross High School, state runner-up and scholar-athlete award recipient.
- » Rounding out the freshmen class is a native of Athens,

Greece. Prapa was a member of the U16 Greece National Team in 2016 and 2018. She led the American Community School of Athens (ACS) to the Greek League Championship and was named the Most Valuable Player.

## FAMILIAR FACES

- » Pitt returns numerous starters from a year ago including senior **Kauai Bradley**, **Danielle Garven**, **Kalista Walters** and **Jasmine Whitney**.
- » Walters ranked second in scoring a year ago with 281 (9.4 ppg), while Whitney was close behind with 230 (7.7 ppg).
- » Redshirt senior **Aysia Bugg**, who has started 92 games in her career, is back for her last season with the Panthers after having sat out the 2017-18 season due to injury.
- » Pitt also returns experienced players in junior **Alayna Gribble** and sophomore **Kyla Nelson**. Gribble saw action in 22 games, while starting 14 and led the team in three-pointers with 42. Nelson ranked second in three's a year ago, knocking down 30.

## SCHOOL DAY

- » The Panthers' season opener against UCF (Nov. 7) marked the 10th year of the School Day promotion at the Petersen Events Center. School Day is an opportunity for local area students to visit one of the top research universities in the country and watch live Division I basketball, while participating in fun contests and learning activities.
- » The School Day game dates back to November 2009. Pitt is 7-3 all-time when hosting the promotion, winning three of its last four contests.
- » Last season, a School Day-record 10,587 fans attended the game, besting the previous mark of 9,771 set in 2016.

- » Pittsburgh is one of six NCAA Division I schools to hire new coaches for both men's and women's basketball, including Chicago State, Delaware State, La Salle, Longwood and Ole Miss.
- » The 2018-19 season marks the fourth time in Pitt basketball history that there is a new head coach for both the men's and women's teams. **Lance White** is in his first year on the women's side while **Jeff Capel** takes over the men's program.

## WELCOME TO THE ACC

- » **Lance White** is one of four new head coaches in the Atlantic Coast Conference, joining Boston College's Joanna Bernabei-McNamee, Clemson's Amanda Butler and Virginia's Tina Thompson.

## ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- » Pitt will meet Northwestern for the first time in 37 years when the teams face off in the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Challenge Thursday, Nov. 29, at the newly renovated Welsh-Ryan Arena in Evanston, Ill.
- » The game will be Pitt's fifth in the Challenge as a member of the ACC, with a 1-3 all-time record. In last season's

game, the Panthers dropped a heartbreaker at home against Wisconsin, 58-57 (Nov. 29, 2017).

- » The ACC owns eight Challenge titles and an 81-55 overall mark in Challenge games since its inception in 2007. The ACC has won at least six games in every Challenge.
- » Pitt leads Northwestern in the all-time series 2-1, with the Panthers claiming the last two meetings. Pitt won the most recent contest, 76-74, in Evanston (Jan. 17, 1981).

- » Redshirt senior **Aysia Bugg** returns to the hardwood for the Panthers after sitting out the 2017-18 season due to injury. The point guard led Pitt with 3.4 assists per game in 2016-17 and was fourth on the squad with 7.1 points per game.

## MOVING UP THE CHART

- » Junior guard **Alayna Gribble** ranks 10th in program history with 96 made 3-pointers for her career. She sits 17 3-pointers away from ninth place, a mark of 113 held by Alecia Balic (1995-98). The Pitt record (166) is held by Erin Maloy (1990-94), putting Gribble on pace with the record.

## WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- » The Panthers return 73.3 percent of its offensive production from 2017-18, including No. 2 and 3 scorers **Kalista Walters** (9.4 ppg), **Alayna Gribble** and **Jasmine Whitney** (both 7.7 ppg). Walters led the ACC in field goal percentage last season with 66.7 percent efficiency. Gribble was the team's top performer from 3-point range, averaging 1.9 treys made per game. Whitney led the Panthers with 4.5 assists per contest.

**Lance White** was introduced as the ninth head coach of Pitt women's basketball in program history Thursday, April 19, 2018.

White comes to Pitt after spending the past 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons with 20 or more wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

Since White's arrival at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Florida State reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

Considered by Florida State head coach Sue Semrau to be one of the rising stars of the coaching profession when she hired him in 2003, White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

White came to Florida State from Texas Tech where he spent 11 seasons, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

As a high school athlete in Spur, he was a three-time All-District selection, two-time All-Region, and two-time third team all-state choice in basketball. His high school basketball and football teams advanced to the regional round both his junior and senior years. In addition to his football and basketball accolades, he was listed in the Spalding Top 100 tennis players in 1991.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.
